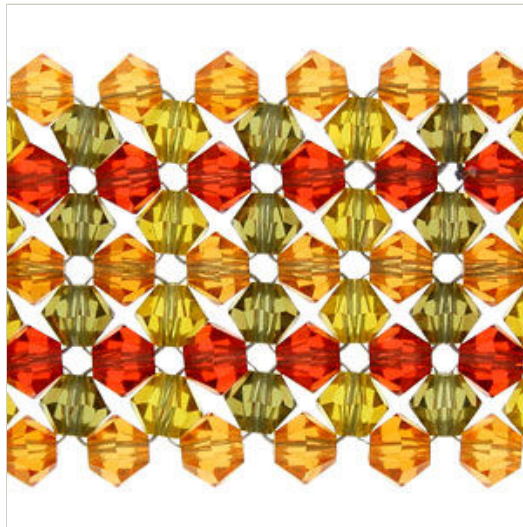

Techniques: Basic Right Angle Weave

Basic right angle weave is a must-learn for any new bead weaver. The structural nature of this weave allows for many possibilities for necklaces, bracelets, and pendants. Play with color, pattern, and different types of beads for endless design possibilities.

Materials

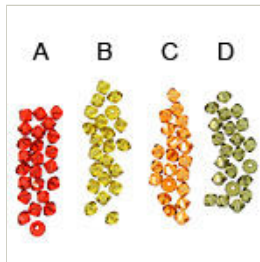
- Beads (We used 4 colors of 4mm CRYSTALLIZED™ - Swarovski Elements Bicone beads - they fit nicely together.)
- Fire Line size B, 4lb.

Tools

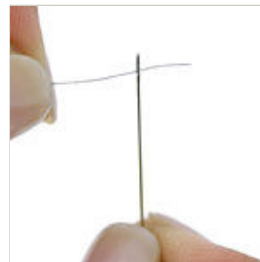
- Size 12 Beading Needles
- Thread Heaven
- Scissors

Tip: Try to keep your tension on your thread tight.

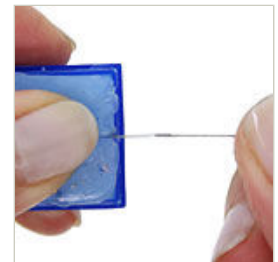
Tip: This weave is created by moving your thread in a figure 8 pattern.



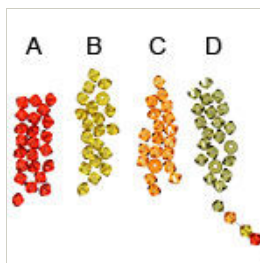
Step 1
For a basic right angle weave design, choose the colors you want to work with. For this technique, I have chosen four colors - color A, color B, color C, and color D.



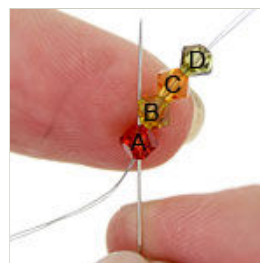
Step 2
Cut a piece of thread about 8 feet long. Thread your needle to the middle of the thread. This will allow you to use double thread which will make your finished piece stronger.



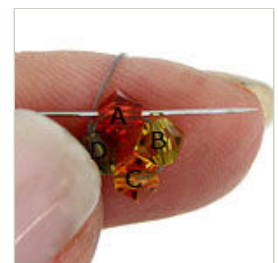
Step 3
Use Thread Heaven to condition your thread. This will help prevent fraying.



Step 4
String 4 beads onto your thread (A, B, C, D).

Bring the beads down towards the end of your thread (leave

Go back through bead A. Repeat steps 9 through 14 until you have reached your desired width for your piece. We have created a four 4-bead unit section.



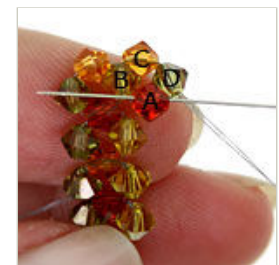

Add 3 beads (C, D, A).



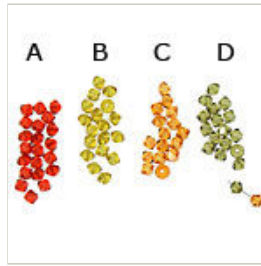
