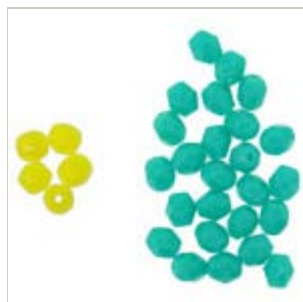
### Materials

- 30 beads (we used 2 colors of 4mm fire polished beads)
- Toho Clear Beading Thread (we used size .16mm)

### Tools

- Size 12 Beading Needles
- Scissors

**Tip:** Try using crystal bicone beads or pearls for a different look.



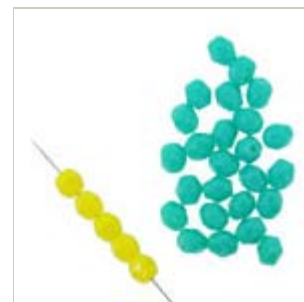
### Step 1

For this technique, we are using 5-4mm beads for your first color and 25-4mm beads for your second color.



### Step 2

Cut a piece of thread about 5 feet long, and thread your needle.



### Step 3

String 5 beads using your first color.

- Gold Charms
- Brass Charms
- Copper Charms

**Step 4**  
Bring the beads down toward the end of your thread, leaving a 3-inch tail. Go back through your beads starting with bead A, followed by bead B, bead C, bead D, and bead E.



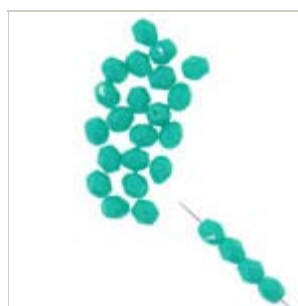
**Step 5**  
Pull your thread taut. This will create your first 5-bead ring.



**Step 6**  
Go back through your beads to reinforce a couple of times. End by going back through bead A.



**Step 7**  
Pull the thread taut. Both ends of the thread should be going through opposite directions of bead A.



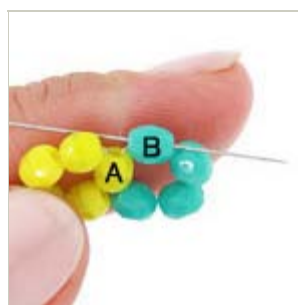
**Step 8**  
Add 4 beads using your second color.



**Step 9**  
Go back through bead A of your first bead ring.



**Step 10**  
Pull the thread taut. This will create your second 5-bead ring.



**Step 11**  
Go through bead B of your second bead ring.



**Step 12**  
Add 3 beads using your second color.

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**Step 13**

Go through bead B of your first bead ring and bead B of your second bead ring.



**Step 14**

Pull the thread taut. This will create your third 5-bead ring.



**Step 15**

Go through bead C, bead D, and bead E of your third bead ring.



**Step 16**

Go through bead C of your first bead ring.



**Step 17**

Add 3 beads using your second color.



**Step 18**

Go through bead E of your third bead ring and bead C of your first bead ring.



**Step 19**

Pull the thread taut. This will create your fourth bead ring.



**Step 20**

Go through bead D of your first bead ring.



**Step 21**

Add 3 beads using your second color.



**Step 22**

Go through bead E of your fourth bead ring and bead D of your first bead ring.



**Step 23**

Pull the thread taut. This will create your fifth 5-bead ring.



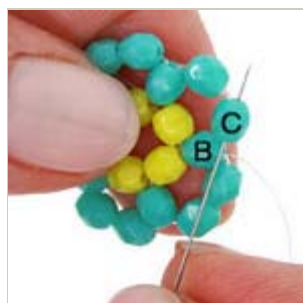
**Step 24**

Go through bead E of your fifth bead ring.



**Step 25**

Add 2 beads using your second color.



**Step 26**

Go through bead E of your second bead ring.



**Step 27**

Go through bead E of your first bead ring. This will create your sixth 5-bead ring.



**Step 28**

Go through bead B and bead C of your sixth bead ring.



**Step 29**

Add 3 beads using your second color.



**Step 30**

Go through bead C of your fifth bead ring and bead C of your sixth bead ring. This will create your seventh 5-bead ring.



**Step 31**

Go through bead E of your seventh bead ring.



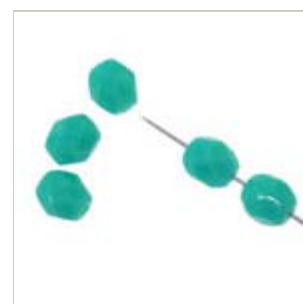
**Step 32**

Add 2 beads using your second color.



**Step 33**

Go through bead D of your second bead ring. This will create your eighth 5-bead ring.



**Step 34**

Go through bead B, bead C, and bead D of your eighth bead ring.



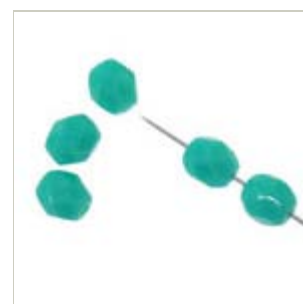
**Step 35**

Go through bead E of your eighth bead ring, go through bead C of your second bead ring, then go through bead C of your third bead ring.



**Step 36**

Add 2 beads using your second color.





**Step 37**  
Go through bead E of your eighth bead ring. Go through bead C of your second bead ring then go through bead C of your third bead ring. This will create your ninth 5-bead ring.



**Step 38**  
Go through bead D of your third bead ring. Go through bead D of your fourth bead ring.



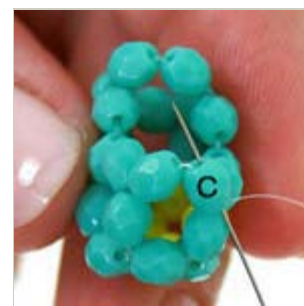
**Step 39**  
Add 2 beads using your second color.



**Step 40**  
Go through bead C of your ninth bead ring. This will create your tenth 5-bead ring.



**Step 41**  
Go through bead A and bead B of your tenth bead ring.



**Step 42**  
Go through bead C of your tenth bead ring.



**Step 43**  
Add 1 bead using your second color.



**Step 44**  
Go through bead C of your seventh bead ring.



**Step 45**  
This will make your eleventh and twelfth 5-bead rings at the same time.



**Step 46**

The woven beaded bead is not stiff and needs to be reinforced. To reinforce, go through bead B, bead C, bead D, bead E, and then bead A again.



**Step 49**

Congratulations! You have now completed your woven beaded bead.

**Step 47**

Continue reinforcing each 5-bead ring on the woven beaded bead several times to make the bead stiff.

**Step 48**

Once all of the twelve 5-bead rings of the woven beaded bead have been reinforced, tie a square knot and cut the thread.

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
