Beads and other products needed for one bracelet:

- 10 - 4mm Burgundy Swarovski Elements Crystal Bicone Beads (04BI1169)
- 10 - 4mm Smoked Topaz Swarovski Elements Crystal Bicone Beads (04BI1138)
- 10 - 4mm Fuchsia Swarovski Elements Crystal Bicone Beads (04BI1109)
- 9 - 4mm Crystal Red Magma Swarovski Elements Crystal Bicone Beads (04BI1438)
- 10 - 4mm Silk Swarovski Elements Crystal Bicone Beads (04BI1287)
- 7 - 15x15mm Sterling Silver Square Swiss Cheese Links (SS3766)
- 1 - 26x15mm Sterling Silver Diamond Magnetic Clasp (SS3669)
- 49 - 6mm Sterling Silver 18 Gauge Open Jump Rings (SS4004)
- 8 - 24 gauge Sterling Silver 2 inch Head Pins (SS3968)

Tools needed to complete the bracelet:

Round nose pliers
Chain nose pliers
Wire cutters

Beading Techniques needed to complete the bracelet:

Opening and Closing a Jump Ring
Wire Wrapping

Instructions to complete “Creative-Link” bracelet:

Tip

Beads are used randomly in this design. Mix all beads together in a small bowl, and select beads randomly from the mix.

Step 1

Place any one crystal bicone bead onto a head pin, making one unit. Wire wrap (see Wire Wrapping Technique) this unit to one outer hole on one Swiss cheese link.

Step 2

Repeat Step 1 six times, wire wrapping six more beads to the outer holes of the same link, leaving one corner hole empty.

Step 3

Repeat Steps 1 – 2 with each of the remaining Swiss cheese links.

Step 4

Open one jump ring (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique). Use the jump ring to attach the empty hole in one corner of one link to the empty hole in one corner of a second link. Close the jump ring.

Step 5

Repeat Step 4 with the remaining links, connecting them into a chain.

Step 6

Open two jump rings. Use one jump ring to attach the loop on one side of the clasp to a corner on one end link and the other jump ring to attach the other side of the clasp to a corner on the other end link. Close both jump rings.
