

# Sugar 'n' Spice by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: 2.5 inches

## **Beads and other products needed for one pair of earrings:**

- 18 - 4mm Burgundy Swarovski Elements Crystal Bicone Beads (04BI1169)
- 18 - 4mm Smoked Topaz Swarovski Elements Crystal Bicone Beads (04BI1138)
- 18 - 4mm Light Colorado Topaz Swarovski Elements Crystal Bicone Beads (04BI1135)
- 18 - 4mm Light Peach Swarovski Elements Crystal Bicone Beads (04BI1103)
- 18 - 4mm Silk Swarovski Elements Crystal Bicone Beads (04BI1287)
- 2 - 17mm Sterling Silver Triangle Ring Links (SS3852)
- 1 pair - 9mm Sterling Silver Ear Wires with Front Loop (SS2600)
- 10 - 22 gauge Sterling Silver 2 inch Head Pins (SS2501)

## **Tools needed to complete the earrings:**

- Round nose pliers
- Chain nose pliers
- Wire cutters

## **Beading Techniques needed to complete the earrings:**

- Attaching an Ear Wire
- Simple Loop

## **Instructions to complete “Sugar ‘n’ Spice” earrings:**

### **Step 1**

Place nine 4mm Burgundy crystal bicone beads onto one head pin, making one unit.

### **Step 2**

Turn a simple loop (see Simple Loop Technique) at the open end of the head pin. Attach the loop just made to one corner loop on one triangle ring link.

### **Step 3**

In the same manner as in the previous steps, use simple loops on eye pins to attach these beads to the next four loops on one edge of the same triangle ring link:

2<sup>nd</sup> loop: 9 – 4mm Smoked Topaz bicone beads

3<sup>rd</sup> loop: 9 – 4mm Light Colorado Topaz bicone beads

4<sup>th</sup> loop: 9 – 4mm Light Peach bicone beads

5<sup>th</sup> loop: 9 – 4mm Silk bicone beads

### **Step 4**

Open the loop on one ear wire (see Attaching an Ear Wire Technique), and attach it to the point on the triangle ring link opposite from the side attached to the beads. Close the loop.

### **Step 5**

Repeat Steps 1 – 4 for the second earring.
