

# Peek-a-Boo Paisley Earrings by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: 1.75 inches

## **Beads and other products needed for one pair of earrings:**

- 4 - 5mm Lime Swarovski Elements Crystal Bicone Beads (05BI1134)
- 4 - 6mm Chrysolite AB Swarovski Elements Crystal Bicone Beads (06BI1185)
- 4 inches - 8.7mm Sterling Silver Paisley Chain (CN0175)
- 1 pair - 15mm Sterling Silver French Ear Wires with 3mm Bead (SS4035)
- 2 - 4.5mm Sterling Silver 22 Gauge Open Jump Rings (SS3893)
- 1 foot - 26 Gauge Silver-Filled Dead Soft Wire (WW0125)

## **Tools needed to complete the earrings:**

- Round nose pliers
- Chain nose pliers
- Wire cutters

## **Beading Techniques needed to complete the earrings:**

- Opening and Closing a Jump Ring
- Attaching an Ear Wire

## **Instructions to complete “Peek-a-Boo Paisley” earrings:**

### **Step 1**

Using wire cutters, cut four single links of chain.

### **Step 2**

Anchor a 3-inch length of wire onto one side of one chain link by wrapping it about three times. String one 5mm Lime crystal bicone bead onto the wire. Anchor the bead in place inside the chain link opening close to one narrow end of the link by wrapping the wire around the opposite side of the link. Trim both wire tails close to the chain link.

### **Step 3**

Repeat Step 1 with one 6mm Chrysolite AB crystal bicone bead, attaching the bead to the space inside the wider end of the link.

### **Step 4**

Repeat Steps 2 – 3 with one more chain link.

### **Step 5**

Open one jump ring (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique). Use the jump ring to connect one chain link to the second. Close the jump ring.

### **Step 6**

Open the loop on one ear wire (see Attaching an Ear Wire Technique), and attach it to the upper chain link. Close the loop.

### **Step 7**

Repeat Steps 1 – 6 for the second earring.
