- 5 - 6mm Rose Swarovski Crystal Round Beads (06RD0107)
- 5 - 6mm Fuchsia Swarovski Crystal Round Beads (06RD0109)
- 5 - 6mm Rose Water Opal Swarovski Crystal Round Beads (06RD0260)
- 5 - 8mm Light Rose Swarovski Crystal Round Beads (08RD0106)
- 5 - 8mm Rose Swarovski Crystal Round Beads (08RD0107)
- 5 - 8mm Fuchsia Swarovski Crystal Round Beads (08RD0109)
- 5 - 8mm Rose Water Opal Swarovski Crystal Round Beads (08RD0243)
- 4 - 8mm Fuchsia Swarovski Crystal Butterfly Beads (SC3695)
- 1 - 16.3x7.2mm Antique Gold Plated Awareness Ribbon Charm (GP6230)
- 7 inches - 7mm Natural Brass Etched Cable Chain (CN4000)
- 1 - 13mm Antique Gold Plated Classic Toggle Clasp (GP2143)

Tools needed to complete the bracelet:

- Wire cutters
- Chain nose pliers
- Round nose pliers

Beading Techniques needed to complete the bracelet:

- Opening and Closing a Jump Ring
- Wire Wrapping

Instructions to complete “For My Girls” bracelet:

Tip

The links of the natural brass chain are not soldered, so they can be opened and closed like jump rings.

Step 1

Using chain nose pliers, open the end link of a 7-inch length of natural brass etched cable chain (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique). Place one side of the antique gold plated classic toggle clasp onto the chain link, and close the chain link.

Step 2

Open the chain link at the other end of the chain. Place the other side of the toggle clasp **and** the antique gold plated awareness ribbon charm onto the chain link. Close the chain link.

Step 3

Place one natural brass bead cap and one 8mm Fuchsia Swarovski crystal round bead onto a gold-filled head pin, making one unit. Wire wrap (see Wire Wrapping Technique) this unit to the end chain link used in Step 2.

Step 4

Place one 6mm Rose Water Opal crystal bead onto a head pin. Wire wrap this unit to the opposite side of the chain link used in Step 3.

Step 5

Place one 6mm Light Rose crystal bead onto a head pin. Moving down the chain toward the opposite end, wire wrap this unit to the next chain link.

Step 6

Place one 8mm Rose crystal bead and one antique gold-plated bead cap onto a head pin. Wire wrap this unit to the opposite side of the chain link used in Step 5.

Tip

The remainder of the bracelet is made by wire wrapping units to the chain links in the same fashion as in the previous steps. To simplify the instructions, the subsequent steps will list the beads used in each unit and indicate which chain link to attach the unit to. In some cases, a second unit is attached to the opposite side of the same chain link. Note that on some units, the bead cap is next to the head pin's head, while on others it is on the other side of the bead. Place the items onto the head pin in the sequence indicated.

Step 7

Wire wrap these units to the specified chain links:

Next chain link: one 6mm Rose crystal bead

Opposite side: one brass bead cap and one 8mm Light Rose crystal bead

Next chain link: one 6mm Fuchsia crystal bead

Opposite side: one 8mm Rose Water Opal crystal bead and one gold-plated bead cap

Next chain link: one Fuchsia Butterfly bead

Next chain link: one 6mm Rose Water Opal crystal bead

Opposite side: one 8mm Fuchsia crystal bead and one gold-plated bead cap

Next chain link: one 6mm Light Rose crystal bead

Opposite side: one brass bead cap and one 8mm Rose crystal bead

Next chain link: one 6mm Rose crystal bead

Opposite side: one 8mm Light Rose crystal and one gold-plated bead cap

Next chain link: one 6mm Fuchsia crystal bead

Opposite side: one brass bead cap and one 8mm Rose Water Opal crystal bead

Next chain link: one Fuchsia Butterfly bead

Step 8

Repeat Steps 3 - 7 one full time.

Step 9

Repeat Steps 5 and 6 once more.

Step 10

Repeat **only the first two** sequences of Step 7 once more, wire wrapping these units to the last link of chain.

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
