Beads and other products needed for one bracelet:

- 12 beads - 6mm Olive Jade Round Beads (SE2417)
- 32 beads - 6mm Rhodonite Round Beads (SE2427)
- 30 - 5mm Silver Plated Beaded Heishis (SP0105)
- 1 - 4.5mm Sterling Silver Alphabet Bead - A (SS0100)
- 3 - 4.5mm Sterling Silver Alphabet Beads - E (SS0104)
- 1 - 4.5mm Sterling Silver Alphabet Bead - P (SS0115)
- 1 - 4.5mm Sterling Silver Alphabet Bead - S (SS0118)
- 1 - 4.5mm Sterling Silver Alphabet Bead - T (SS0119)
- 1 - 4.5mm Sterling Silver Alphabet Bead - W (SS0122)
- 2 - 9x4mm Sterling Silver Rondelle Spacers - 2 Strand (SS2402)
- 1 - 11x16mm Sterling Silver Two Strand Oval Toggle Clasp (SS3659)
- 4 - 2x2mm Sterling Silver Crimp Beads (SS4047)
- 4 - 3.4mm Sterling Silver Crimp Bead Covers (SS2103)
- 2 feet - Clear Soft Flex Beading Wire .014 Diameter (SM0310)

Tools needed to complete the bracelet:

- Wire cutters
- Crimping pliers (TL0500)

Beading Techniques needed to complete the bracelet:

- Crimping
- Crimp Bead Covers

Instructions to complete “My Little One” bracelet:

Tip

This two strand bracelet is easiest to make when you string both strands simultaneously.

Step 1

Place one crimp bead and one hole on one side of the sterling silver two strand toggle clasp onto a 1-foot length of beading wire. Pass the wire back through the crimp bead, and crimp the crimp bead (see Crimping Technique).

Step 2

Cover the crimp bead with a crimp cover (see Crimp Bead Covers Technique), and trim excess wire with wire cutters.

Step 3

Repeat Steps 1 and 2, attaching a second 1-foot length of beading wire to the second hole on the **same** side of the toggle clasp used in the previous steps.

Step 4

String these beads in the following sequence onto one of the lengths of beading wire:

**2 - rhodonite round beads

1 - silver plated heishi

1 - olive jade round bead

1 - heishi

Repeat from the ** three times, omitting the heishi, olive jade, and heishi from the third repeat

Step 5

Repeat Step 4, stringing the beads onto the second length of beading wire.

Step 6

String one hole of one sterling silver rondelle two strand spacer onto one of the lengths of beading wire, and string the other hole onto the other length of wire.

Step 7

String these beads in the following sequence onto one of the lengths of beading wire:

1 - sterling S alphabet bead

1 - sterling W bead

2 - sterling E beads

1 - sterling T bead

One hole of a second two strand spacer

Step 8

String these beads in the following sequence onto the second length of beading wire:

3 - heishis

1 - sterling P bead

1 - sterling E bead

1 - sterling A bead

3 - heishis

The other hole of the two strand spacer from Step 7

Step 9

Repeat Steps 4 and 5, reversing the string sequence.

Step 10

Place one crimp bead and one hole of the other side of the toggle clasp onto one length of beading wire. Pass the wire back through the crimp bead, crimp the crimp bead, cover with a crimp cover, and trim excess wire with wire cutters.

Step 11

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Repeat Step 10 with the other length of beading wire.

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
