

# Daisy Lu by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: 15.75 inches

## **Beads and other products needed for one necklace:**

Approximately 3 grams (1 bag) - Size 8 Silver Lined Matte Peridot Green Round Japanese Seed Beads (SB1237)

Approximately 3 grams (1 bag) - Size 8 Matte Opaque Sunshine Yellow Round Japanese Seed Beads (SB1239)

Approximately 3 grams (1 bag) - Size 8 Opaque White AB Round Japanese Seed Beads (SB1258)

Approximately 3 grams (1 bag) - Size 8 Silver Lined Transparent Opal Dusty Rose Round Japanese Seed Beads (SB1071)

1 - 12x7mm Gold Plated Base Metal Lobster Claw Clasp (BM3151)

1 - 6mm Gold Plated Split Ring (BM2628)

Approximately 18 feet - Crystal Clear FireLine Braided Bead Thread Size D (SM4429)

## **Tools needed to complete the necklace:**

Scissors

English Beading Needles, Size 10

## **Beading Techniques needed to complete the necklace:**

Daisy Chain

## **Instructions to complete “Daisy Lu” necklace:**

### **Step 1**

Thread a needle to the center of a length of beading thread approximately 9 feet long, and thread the loop on one gold color lobster claw. Anchor the thread by tying two square knots around the loop of the lobster claw, and trim excess thread with scissors (see Daisy Chain Technique).

### **Step 2**

Weave a daisy chain until it reaches the desired length using silver lined matte peridot green seed beads as the stems (between each daisy), opaque white AB and silver lined transparent opal dusty rose seed beads as the petals of the daisies, and matte opaque sunshine yellow seed beads as the centers of the daisies, alternating between pink and white daisies. For the pictured 15.75-inch necklace, we wove 26 daisies with three peridot stem seed beads between each daisy.

### **Step 3**

Place one gold plated split ring onto the beading thread, and tie two square knots around the ring. Trim any excess thread with scissors.

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
