Approximate finished length: 7 inches

Beads and other products needed for one bracelet:

- 14 - 11x6mm Light Topaz Swarovski Crystal Modular Beads (SC4185)
- 7 - 11x6mm Peridot Swarovski Crystal Modular Beads (SC4187)
- 6 - 1.5x20mm Gold-Filled Plain Curved Tube Beads (GF0152)
- 1 - 6x11.5mm Gold-Filled Oval Lobster Clasp (GF2804)
- 1 - 7mm Gold-Filled Closed Jump Ring (GF2723)
- 2 - 2x2mm Gold-Filled Crimp Beads (GF2788)
- 2 - 3.4mm Gold-Filled Crimp Bead Covers (GF2101)
- 12 inches - Gold Plated Beadalon 19 Strand Beading Wire .015 Diameter (SM0256)

Tools needed to complete the bracelet:

- Wire cutters
- Crimping pliers (TL0500)

Beading Techniques needed to complete the bracelet:

- Crimping
- Crimp Bead Covers

Instructions to complete "Kokomo" bracelet:

Step 1

Place one crimp bead and the loop on one gold-filled lobster clasp onto a 12-inch length of beading wire. Pass the wire back through the crimp bead, and crimp the crimp bead (see Crimping Technique).

Step 2

Cover the crimp bead with a crimp cover (see Crimp Bead Covers Technique), and trim excess wire with wire cutters.

Step 3

String these beads in the following sequence onto the beading wire:

**1 - Peridot Swarovski crystal Modular bead

1 - Light Topaz Modular bead

1 - Peridot Modular bead

1 - gold-filled plain curved tube bead

Repeat from the ** six times, omitting the gold-filled tube bead from the last repeat.

Step 4

Place one crimp bead and one 7mm gold-filled closed jump ring onto the beading wire. Pass the wire back through the crimp bead, crimp the crimp bead, cover with a crimp cover, and trim excess wire with wire cutters.

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
