Approximate finished length: 3 inches

Beads and other products needed for one pair of earrings:

12 pieces (1 bag) – Hearts Cane Glass Slicer Bead Mix (GL7036)

7 inches – 3mm Sterling Silver Heart Chain (CN0140)

12 – 6.5mm Sterling Silver 20.5 Gauge Jump Rings (SS3926)

1 pair – 21mm Sterling Silver Ear Wires with Hearts (SS4040)

Tools needed to complete the earrings:

Wire cutters

Chain nose pliers

Instructions to complete “Heart of Mine” earrings:

Tip

The Hearts can glass slicer bead mix is made up of a random assortment of shapes and sizes, so have fun mixing the beads to make a pair of asymmetrical earrings like ours. You can also make a matched pair by choosing similar beads.

Step 1

Using wire cutters, cut the sterling silver heart chain into two 3.5-inch lengths.

Step 2

Slide one 3.5-inch length of chain through the hole of one large heart slicer bead from the Hearts can glass slicer bead mix.

Step 3

Using chain nose pliers, open the loop on one sterling silver ear wire (see Attaching an Ear Wire Technique). Place both ends of the segment of chain from Step 2 onto the ear wire, and close the ear wire.

Step 4

Using chain nose pliers, open one sterling silver jump ring (see Add a Charm to a Chain Technique). Use the jump ring to connect one smaller heart slicer bead to any chain link. Close the jump ring.

Step 5

Repeat Step 4 four times, attaching four smaller heart slicer beads to any links. In the earrings pictured, two beads are on one side of the chain, and three are on the other.

Step 6

Repeat Steps 2 – 5 for the second earring.

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
