## **Beads and other products needed for one bracelet:**

- 10 - 5mm Silver Plated Nugget Heishi (SP0297)
- 14 - 6mm Green Emerald Bicone Czech Pressed Glass Beads (GL1826)
- 1 - 6x7mm Rhodium Plated Alphabet Bead - C (SP0202)
- 1 - 6x7mm Rhodium Plated Alphabet Bead - E (SP0204)
- 2 - 6x7mm Rhodium Plated Alphabet Bead - O (SP0214)
- 1 - 6x7mm Rhodium Plated Alphabet Bead - P (SP0215)
- 1 - 6x7mm Rhodium Plated Alphabet Bead - R (SP0217)
- 4 - 6x7mm Rhodium Plated Alphabet Bead - Blank (SP0242)
- 1 - 5x17.5mm Sterling Silver Bat and Ball Charm (SS7114)
- 1 - 9mm Sterling Silver Toggle Clasp (SS3100)
- 1 - 4.8mm Sterling Silver 19 Gauge Jump Ring (SS3947)
- 2 - 2x2mm Sterling Silver Crimp Bead (SS4047)
- 10 inches - Clear Soft Flex Beading Wire .014 diameter (SM0310)

## **Tools needed to complete the bracelet:**

- Chain nose pliers
- Wire cutters
- Crimping pliers (TL0500)

## **Beading Techniques needed to complete the bracelet:**

- Crimping
- Opening and Closing a Jump Ring

## **Instructions to complete “Momma’s Boy” bracelet:**

### **Step 1**

Place one crimp bead and one side of the toggle clasp onto a 10-inch length of beading wire. Pass the wire back through the crimp bead, and crimp the crimp bead (see Crimping Technique). Trim excess wire with wire cutters.

### **Step 2**

String these beads in the following sequence onto the beading wire:

\*1 - heishi

1 - 6mm green emerald bicone glass bead

1 - blank alphabet bead

1 - 6mm green emerald bicone glass bead

1 - heishi

1 - 6mm green emerald bicone glass bead

1 - heishi

1 - 6mm green emerald bicone glass bead

1 - blank alphabet bead

1 - 6mm green emerald bicone glass bead

1 - heishi

1 - 6mm green emerald bicone glass bead

1 - heishi

1 - 6mm green emerald bicone glass bead\*\*

String the alphabet beads for the letters you've chosen. In the photo, the following beads are used:

1 - C alphabet bead

1 - O alphabet bead

1 - O alphabet bead

1 - P alphabet bead

1 - E alphabet bead

1 - R alphabet bead

Reverse the first stringing sequence (from \* through \*\*).

### **Step 3**

String one crimp bead and the other side of the toggle clasp. Pass the wire back through the crimp bead, crimp the crimp bead, and trim excess wire with wire cutters.

### **Step 4**

Using chain nose pliers, open the jump ring (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique), and use it to attach the bat and ball charm to loop on the ring side of the toggle clasp. Close the jump ring.

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
