

# Spider Web by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: 18 inches

## **Beads and other products needed for one necklace:**

- 1 - 38x33mm Antique Sterling Silver Plated Pewter Grande Circle Deep Bezel Pendant by Nunn Design (PE8502)
- 1 - Orange Crush Ultrafine Transparent Glitter (CR0122)
- 30.5 inches - 1.9mm Gunmetal Plated Base Metal Chain (CN4009)
- 1 - 9.5x5.5mm Gunmetal Plated Base Metal Lobster Claw Clasp (BM3145)
- 4 - Brass Open Jump Ring by TierraCast® - Gunmetal - 20 gauge - 5.5mm (MP6037)
- 3 - 6mm Gunmetal Plated Base Metal 20 Gauge Open Jump Rings (BM2766)
- Cardstock scrap

## **Tools needed to complete the necklace:**

- Chain nose pliers
- Wire cutters
- Ice Resin (TL2167)
- 1 1/4 inch Circle Punch (TL2169)
- Permanent marker, fine tip

## **Beading Techniques needed to complete the necklace:**

- Opening and Closing a Jump Ring
- Cutting Chain Efficiently
- Using ICE Resin with Picture Frames
- Adding Color to ICE Resin
- Making a Domed Surface with ICE Resin

## Instructions to complete "Spider Web" necklace:

### **Step 1**

Cut the chain into the following lengths (see Cutting Chain Efficiently Technique):

- 2 - 0.5" lengths
- 2 - 3.5" lengths
- 1 - 3.75" length
- 1 - 5.25" length
- 1 - 6" length
- 1 - 7.25" length

### **Step 2**

Using the circle punch, punch out a circle from a cardstock scrap.

### **Step 2**

Place the round paper shape inside the collage pendant. Mix glitter with the resin (see Adding Color to ICE Resin Technique), pour a small layer of the glitter resin into the collage pendant and allow the resin to set completely (see Using ICE Resin with Picture Frames Technique). Do not fill the pendant completely.

### **Step 3**

Using a permanent marker, draw a spider web pattern onto the resin surface.

### **Step 4**

Give the pendant a domed surface (see Making a Domed Surface with ICE Resin Technique).

### **Step 5**

Open one 6mm jump ring (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique). Use the jump ring to attach the collage pendant to the 5.25-inch length chain about 1 inch from one end by passing the ring through a link. Close the jump ring.

### **Tip**

*The three chain swags in the central area of the necklace are arranged asymmetrically and connected with jump rings. Refer to the photo as you follow the instructions below. The left side of the necklace will be assembled first, starting from the pendant and moving upward. The right side will be assembled last.*

### **Step 6**

Open one 5.5mm jump ring. Use the jump ring to connect the shorter end of chain from Step 5, one 3.75-inch length and one 0.5-inch length (the longest chain will extend toward the right side of the necklace). Close the jump ring.

### **Step 7**

Open one 5.5mm jump ring. Use the jump ring to connect the other side of the 0.5-inch length from Step 6, one 3.5-inch length and one 0.5-inch length (the longest chain will extend toward the right side of the necklace). Close the jump ring.

### **Step 8**

Open one 5.5mm jump ring. Use the jump ring to connect the other side of the 0.5-inch length from Step 7, one 3.5-inch length and one 7.5-inch length (the 3.5-inch length of chain will extend toward the right side of the necklace; the 7.5-inch length will extend up toward the back of the necklace). Close the jump ring.

### **Step 9**

Open one 6mm jump ring, and use it to connect the lobster claw to the open end of the 7.5-inch length of chain from Step 8. Close the jump ring. The left side of the necklace is complete.

**Step 10**

Open one 5.5mm jump ring. Use the jump ring to connect the longer end of chain from Step 5, the three open end links of the 3.75-inch length and 3.5-inch lengths from the previous steps and the 6-inch length of chain (the 6-inch length will extend up toward the back of the necklace). Close the jump ring.

**Step 11**

Open the last 6mm jump ring, and attach it to the open end link of the 6-inch length of chain from Step 10 to catch the lobster claw. The right side of the necklace is complete.

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
