

Spider Bite by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: adjustable

Beads and other products needed for one necklace:

- 1 - Volare Ultrafine Transparent Glitter (CR0108)
- 1 - 12 Piece Oil Color Set (CR0272)
- 1 - 18.5mm Sterling Silver Round Glue-On Bail (SS8458)
- 1 - 14mm Black Silk Ribbon (SM4613)
- 1 - plastic spider

Tools needed to complete the necklace:

- ICE Resin (TL2167)
- 38mm Domes Resin Mold (CR0227)
- E600 Adhesive (TL1681)
- Emery board
- Buffing block

Beading Techniques needed to complete the necklace:

- Using ICE Resin with a Mold
- Adding Color to ICE Resin
- Finishing ICE Resin – Filing
- Gluing on a Bail

Instructions to complete “Spider Bite” necklace:

Step 1

Mix the two parts of the resin (see Using ICE Resin with a Mold Technique). When mixed thoroughly, fill the domed mold about halfway with resin. Allow the resin to soft cure. Place a plastic spider onto the soft-cured resin layer.

Step 2

Mix a small amount of resin, and pour a thin layer over the spider to cover it. Allow the resin to soft cure.

Step 3

Mix blue and red oil pigments and glitter with a small amount of mixed resin to make purple resin (see Adding Color to ICE Resin Technique). Fill the mold with colored resin. Allow it to set completely.

Step 4

Remove the pendant from the mold, and file the edges smooth (see Finishing ICE Resin – Filing Technique).

Step 5

Using a small drop of E6000 adhesive, adhere the glue-on bail to the back of the pendant (see Gluing on a Bail Technique). Allow the adhesive to dry completely.

Step 6

Slide the ribbon through the bail. Tie into a knot and bow at the desired length to fasten.

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
