Approximate finished length: 16 inches

Beads and other products needed for one necklace:

- 82 - 4-4.5mm Pink Potato Freshwater Pearls (PL0571)
- 8 - 5mm Gold Plated Round Seamed Beads (BM2565)
- 4 - 6mm Olivine Matte Round Czech Pressed Glass Beads (GL1361)
- 4 - 8mm Opaque Purple Flower Czech Pressed Glass Beads (GL0935)
- 1 - Antique Gold Plated Pewter Easter Bunny Charm (PG0561)
- 1 - 12x7mm Gold Plated Base Metal Lobster Claw Clasp (BM3151)
- 1 - 6mm Gold Plated Base Metal 19 Gauge Open Jump Ring (BM2800)
- 1 - 6mm Gold-Filled 19 Gauge Closed Jump Ring (GF2722)
- 2 - 1.5x1.5mm Gold Plated Crimp Beads (BM2528)
- 2 - 3mm Gold Plated Crimp Bead Covers (BM3061)
- 1.5 feet - Clear Soft Flex Beading Wire .014 diameter (SM0310)

Tools needed to complete the necklace:

- Chain nose pliers
- Wire cutters
- Crimping pliers (TL0500)

Beading Techniques needed to complete the necklace:

- Opening and Closing a Jump Ring
- Crimping
- Crimp Bead Covers

Instructions to complete “Hop to It” necklace:

Step 1

Open the jump ring (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique), and attach the jump ring to the Easter bunny charm. Close the jump ring.

Step 2

String one crimp bead and the lobster claw onto a 1.5-foot length of beading wire. Pass the beading wire back through the crimp bead, and crimp the crimp bead (see Crimping Technique).

Step 3

Cover the crimp bead with a crimp bead cover (see Crimp Bead Covers Technique), and trim excess wire with wire cutters.

Step 4

String these beads in the following sequence onto the beading wire:

25 – pearls
1 – 6mm olivine matte round bead
2 – pearls
1 – 5mm gold bead
2 – pearls
1 – 8mm opaque purple flower bead
2 – pearls
1 – 5mm gold bead
2 – pearls
1 – 6mm olivine matte round bead
2 – pearls
1 – 5mm gold bead
2 – pearls
1 – 8mm opaque purple flower bead
2 – pearls
1 – 5mm gold bead
2 – pearls
The jump ring on the charm

Repeat the stringing sequence in reverse.

Step 5

String one crimp bead and the closed jump ring onto the beading wire. Pass the wire back through the crimp bead, and crimp the crimp bead. Cover the crimp with a crimp bead cover, and trim excess wire with wire cutters.
