Approximate finished length: 1.3 inches

Beads and other products needed for one pair of earrings:

- 1 bag - Size 8 Periwinkle Purple Lined Purple Round Japanese Seed Beads (SB0971)
- 1 pair - 30mm Sterling Silver Endless Hoop Earrings (SS4788)
- 3 feet - Crystal Clear FireLine Braided Bead Thread .008 diameter, 6 lb/Size D (SM4429)

Tools needed to complete the earrings:

- Chain nose pliers
- Scissors
- English Beading Needles, Size 10
- Perfect End Thread Burner

Beading Techniques needed to complete the earrings:

- Brick Stitch on a Component
- Using a Perfect End Thread Burner

Instructions to complete “Mulberry” earrings:

Step 1

Using a 1.5-foot length of beading thread, stitch two rows of brick stitch, 10 beads per row, onto the lower edge of one hoop earring (see Brick Stitch on a Component Technique).

Step 2

Trim excess beading thread with scissors, and burn the ends with a Perfect End Thread Burner (see Using a Perfect End Thread Burner Technique).

Step 3

Repeat Steps 1 – 2 for the second earring.

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
