Beads and other products needed for one bracelet:

- 20 - 4mm Jet Fire Polished Round Glass Beads (FP0221)
- 10 - 3x6mm Jet Fire Polished Rondelle Glass Beads (FP2733)
- 2 - 7mm Red Glass Bead by T-Beads (HM3005)
- 2 - 7mm Red and Orange Frit with Black Stripes Glass Bead by T-Beads (HM3059)
- 1 - 24x25.5mm Red Frit On White Tab Glass Bead by T-Beads (HM0267)
- 1 - 15mm Gold-Filled Round Toggle Clasp (GF3030)
- 2 - 2x2mm Gold-Filled Crimp Beads (GF2788)
- 2 - 3.5mm Gold-Filled Crimp Bead Covers (GF2101)
- 9.5 inches - Clear Soft Flex Beading Wire .014 diameter (SM0310)

Tools needed to complete the bracelet:

- Wire cutters
- Crimping pliers (TL0500)

Beading Techniques needed to complete the bracelet:

- Crimping
- Crimp Bead Covers

Instructions to complete "Solaris" bracelet:

Step 1

Place one crimp bead and one side of the toggle clasp onto a 9.5-inch length of beading wire. Pass the wire back through the crimp bead, and crimp the crimp bead (see Crimping Technique). Trim excess wire with wire cutters.

Step 2

Cover the crimp bead with a crimp bead cover (see Crimp Bead Covers Technique), and trim excess wire with wire cutters.

Step 3

String these beads in the following sequence onto the beading wire:

- * 2 - 4mm jet fire polished beads
- 1 - 3x6mm jet fire polished rondelle
- 1 - 4mm jet fire polished bead
- 1 - 3x6mm jet fire polished rondelle
- 1 - 4mm jet fire polished bead
- 1 - 3x6mm jet fire polished rondelle
- 1 - 4mm jet fire polished bead
- 1 - 3x6mm jet fire polished rondelle
- 1 - 4mm jet fire polished bead
- 1 - 7mm red and orange frit with black stripes glass bead
- 1 - 4mm jet fire polished bead
- 1 - 3x6mm jet fire polished rondelle
- 1 - 4mm jet fire polished bead
- 1 - 7mm red glass bead
- ** 2 - 4mm jet fire polished beads
- 1 - 14x16mm red frit on white tab glass bead

Reverse the stringing sequence from ** to *.

Step 4

String one crimp bead and the other side of the clasp onto the beading wire. Pass the wire back through the crimp bead, and crimp the crimp bead. Cover the crimp with a crimp bead cover, and trim excess wire with wire cutters.

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
