## **Beads and other products needed for one necklace:**

- 8 - 8mm Crystal Red Magma Swarovski Elements Crystal Round Beads (08RD0282)
- 16 - 4mm Crystal Red Magma Swarovski Elements Crystal Rondelle Beads (SC6380)
- 1 - 22mm Crystal Red Magma Swarovski Elements Pear Shaped Crystal Pendant (SC6473)
- 1 - 33x11.5mm Gunmetal Plated Pewter Hook & Eye Clasp (PW1388)
- 1 - 16.5x5mm Gunmetal Plated Pewter Pinch Bail (PW1348)
- 2 - 6mm 18 gauge Gunmetal Plated Base Metal Jump Rings (BM2839)
- 8 - 22 gauge 2 inch Gunmetal Plated Base Metal Eye Pins (BM2662)
- 13 inches - 5.6mm Gunmetal Plated Base Metal Flat Oval Long and Short Chain (CN5313)

## **Tools needed to complete the necklace:**

Round nose pliers  
Chain nose pliers  
Wire cutters

## **Beading Techniques needed to complete the necklace:**

Opening and Closing a Jump Ring  
Cutting Chain Efficiently  
Attaching a Bail - Style 4  
Simple Loop

## **Instructions to complete "Pele" necklace:**

### **Step 1**

The chain is made of alternating small and large oval links. Cut the chain into the following lengths (see Cutting Chain Efficiently Technique):

- 8 - 1.25 " lengths, each length beginning and ending with a large link
- 1 - 2.5 " length beginning and ending with a large link

### **Step 2**

Attach the bail to the pendant (see Attaching a Bail - Style 4 Technique).

### **Step 3**

Place one 4mm crystal rondelle, one 8mm crystal round bead and one 4mm crystal rondelle onto one eye pin, making one unit. Turn a simple loop (see Simple Loop Technique) at the open end of the eye pin, making sure that the loop is on the same plane as the first loop.

### **Step 4**

Repeat Step 3 seven times, making a total of eight simple loop units.

### **Step 5**

Open one jump ring (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique). Use the jump ring to attach one end link of one 1.25-inch length of chain to the loop on the hook side of the clasp. Close the jump ring.

### **Step 6**

Open one loop on one bead unit from Steps 3 - 4, and attach it to the unattached end link of the chain length used in the previous step. Close the loop.

### **Step 7**

In the same manner as in the previous step, connect units and chain lengths in the following sequence. Each unit or chain length connects to the one listed directly before and directly after it:

- 1 - 1.25 " length of chain
- 1 - bead unit
- 1 - 1.25 " length of chain
- 1 - bead unit
- 1 - 1.25 " length of chain
- 1 - bead unit
- 1 - 2.5 " length of chain

String the bail through the 2.5-inch length of chain. Then continue connecting units and chain lengths in the following sequence:

- 1 - bead unit
- 1 - 1.25 " length of chain
- 1 - bead unit
- 1 - 1.25 " length of chain
- 1 - bead unit
- 1 - 1.25 " length of chain
- 1 - bead unit
- 1 - 1.25 " length of chain

### **Step 8**

Open one jump ring, and use it to connect the unattached end link on the last length of chain to the loop on the ring side of clasp. Close the jump ring.

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
