- 8 - 4mm Light Colorado Topaz Swarovski Elements Crystal Bicone Beads (04BI1135)
- 8 - 4mm Topaz Swarovski Elements Crystal Bicone Beads (04BI1137)
- 8 - 4mm Smoked Topaz Swarovski Elements Crystal Bicone Beads (04BI1138)
- 8 - 11x8mm Bordeaux Swarovski Elements Crystal Drop Pearls (PL6662)
- 1 - 19x7mm Antique Gold Plated Pewter Leaf Charm by Nunn Design (BM0478)

## **Tools needed to complete the bracelet:**

- Round nose pliers
- Chain nose pliers
- Wire cutters
- ICE Resin (TL2167)
- Scissors

## **Beading Techniques needed to complete the bracelet:**

Opening and Closing a Jump Ring  
Simple Loop  
Using ICE Resin with Collage Pendants  
Using Transfer Images with a Collage Pendant  
Making a Domed Surface with ICE Resin  
Adding Color to ICE Resin

## **Instructions to complete “Radiant Wine” bracelet:**

### **Step 1**

Mix the two parts of the resin (see Adding Color to ICE Resin Technique). Color the resin with pigment.

### **Step 2**

Completely fill each of the three collage pendant links with colored resin. Allow the resin to cure.

### **Step 3**

Apply one floral image from the transfer sheet to each collage pendant link's inner surface (see Using Transfer Images with a Collage Pendant Technique). Allow the transfers to dry completely.

### **Step 4**

Mix a small batch of resin, and dome the surface of each pendant link (see Making a Domed Surface with ICE Resin Technique). Allow the resin to cure completely.

### **Step 5**

Place one 3mm Smoked Topaz crystal bicone bead onto a head pin, making one unit. Turn a simple loop (see Simple Loop Technique) at the open end of the head pin. Attach the loop just made to one loop on one pendant link.

### **Step 6**

In the same manner as in the previous step, use simple loops to attach the following bead units to the same pendant link loop:

- 1 – 3mm Light Colorado Topaz bicone bead
- 1 – 3mm Topaz bicone bead

### **Step 7**

Repeat Steps 5 – 6 with each of the two remaining pendant links.

### **Step 8**

Place one 11x8mm Bordeaux crystal drop pearl onto an eye pin, wide end toward the eye, making one unit. Turn a simple loop at the open end of the eye pin.

### **Step 9**

Place one 4mm Smoked Topaz crystal bicone bead onto a head pin, making one unit. Turn a simple loop at the open end of the head pin. Attach the loop just made to the loop next to the wide end of the pearl on the unit made in the previous step.

### **Step 10**

In the same manner as in the previous step, use simple loops to attach the following bead units to the same loop:

- 1 – 4mm Light Colorado Topaz bicone bead
- 1 – 4mm Topaz bicone bead

### **Step 11**

Repeat Steps 8 – 10 with the seven remaining 11x8mm Bordeaux pearls.

**Step 12**

Open the unattached loop on one pearl unit, and attach it to the third chain link on the charm bracelet.

**Step 13**

Repeat Step 12 with the seven remaining pearl units, attaching one to each of the following chain links: seventh, 11th, 15th, 19th, 23rd, 27<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup>.

**Step 14**

Open one jump ring (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique). Use the jump ring to attach the leaf charm to the fifth chain link. Close the jump ring.

**Step 15**

In the same manner as in the previous step, use jump rings to attach the following charms to the specified chain links:

9<sup>th</sup> link: flower charm

17<sup>th</sup> link: heart charm

25<sup>th</sup> link: key charm

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
