## **Beads and other products needed for one pair of earrings:**

- 2 - 25x18mm Oval Glass Domes (GL7066)
- 2 - 32.5x23mm Antique Gold Plated Pewter Oval Rope Edged Bezels by Nunn Design (PE9118)
- 2 - 25x19mm Antique Silver Plated Pewter Oval Bezel Laces by Nunn Design (PE9099)
- 1 pair - 13.5mm Gold-Filled Ear Wires with Bead (GF2107)
- 1 - 4.75x6.75 inch Amy Butler Lotus Designer Mat Pad (CR0502)

## **Tools needed to complete the earrings:**

- Scissors or art knife
- Pencil
- 5 Piece Nylon Brush Set (CR0659)

## **Beading Techniques needed to complete the earrings:**

- Attaching an Ear Wire
- Creating a Bezel Laced Pendant

**Instructions to complete “Camelia” earrings:**

**Step 1**

Trace a glass dome twice onto a sheet of lotus paper with a pencil. Cut out the paper ovals with scissors or an art knife.

**Step 2**

Glue one paper oval to one glass dome and bezel lace (see Creating a Bezel Laced Pendant Technique). Allow to dry completely.

**Step 3**

Open the loop on one ear wire (see Attaching an Ear Wire Technique), and attach it to the loop on the bezel. Close the loop.

**Step 4**

Repeat Steps 2 – 3 for the second earring.

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
