

Midnight Plum by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: 8 inches

Beads and other products needed for one bracelet:

- 10 - 6mm Montana Swarovski Elements Crystal Bicone Beads (06BI1128)
- 9 - Dusk Cane Glass Bead Mix (GL7006)
- 18 - 2x6mm Antique Silver Plated Pewter Beaded Heishi Beads by TierraCast® (SP0106)
- 1 - 16x12mm Silver Plated Pewter Toggle Clasp by TierraCast® (SP2129)
- 2 - 2x2mm Sterling Silver Crimp Beads (SS4047)
- 2 - 3.5mm Sterling Silver Crimp Bead Covers (SS2103)
- 1 foot - Clear Soft Flex Beading Wire .019 diameter (SM0311)

Tools needed to complete the bracelet:

- Wire cutters
- Crimping pliers (TL0500)

Beading Techniques needed to complete the bracelet:

- Crimping
- Crimp Bead Covers

Instructions to complete “Midnight Plum” bracelet:

Tip

The cane glass bead mix contains an assortment of beads that vary from mix to mix. String the beads randomly from the mix.

Step 1

String one crimp bead and the loop on one side of the toggle clasp onto a 12-inch length of beading wire. Pass the wire back through the crimp bead, and crimp the crimp bead (see Crimping Technique).

Step 2

Cover the crimp bead with a crimp cover (see Crimp Bead Covers Technique), and trim excess wire with wire cutters.

Step 3

String these beads in the following sequence onto the beading wire:

1 – 6mm Montana bicone bead

1 – heishi bead spacer

1 – cane glass bead

1 – heishi bead spacer

Repeat the sequence above eight times, adding one 6mm Montana bicone bead to the last sequence.

Step 4

String one crimp bead and the loop on the other side of the toggle clasp. Pass the wire back through the crimp bead, crimp the crimp bead, cover with a crimp cover, and trim excess wire with wire cutters.

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
