

Emerald Opulence by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: 17.5 inches

Beads and other products needed for one necklace:

- 11 - 3mm Lime Swarovski Elements Crystal Bicone Beads (03BI1152)
- 11 - 3mm Olivine AB Swarovski Elements Crystal Bicone Beads (03BI1313)
- 1 - 5mm Olivine AB Swarovski Elements Crystal Bicone Bead (05BI1137)
- 21 - 4mm Emerald Fire Polished Round Glass Beads (FP0237)
- 16 - 6mm Emerald Fire Polished Round Glass Beads (FP0411)
- 1 - 10mm Lime Swarovski Elements Crystal Gold Flower Charm (RI1164)
- 1 - 20x15mm Gold Plated Base Metal Filigree Teardrop with Loop (BM1010)
- 1 - 12x7mm Gold Plated Base Metal Lobster Claw Clasp (BM3151)
- 35 - 5mm 18 gauge Gold Plated Base Metal Jump Rings (BM2833)
- 24 - 24 gauge 2 inch Gold Plated Base Metal Head Pins (BM2692)
- 37 - 24 gauge 2 inch Gold Plated Base Metal Eye Pins (BM2652)

Tools needed to complete the necklace:

Round nose pliers
Chain nose pliers
Wire cutters

Beading Techniques needed to complete the necklace:

Opening and Closing a Jump Ring
Simple Loop

Instructions to complete “Emerald Opulence” necklace:

Step 1

Open one jump ring (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique). Use the jump ring to attach the loop on the charm to the space in the filigree teardrop directly opposite from its point. Close the jump ring.

Step 2

Place one 5mm Olivine AB crystal bicone bead onto one head pin, making one unit. Turn a simple loop (see Simple Loop Technique) at the open end of the head pin. Attach the loop just made to the space on the filigree teardrop to the right of the charm.

Step 3

In the same manner as in Step 2, use simple loops on head pins to attach these beads to the following locations on the filigree teardrop:

- 1 – 3mm Lime bicone bead to the right of the 5mm Olivine AB bicone bead
- 1 – 4mm emerald fire polished bead to the left of the charm
- 1 – 3mm Olivine AB bicone bead to the left of the 4mm emerald fire polished bead

Set aside the completed pendant assembly.

Step 4

Place one 6mm emerald fire polished bead onto one eye pin, making one unit. Turn a simple loop at the open end of the eye pin.

Step 5

Repeat Step 4 fifteen times, making a total of 16 units with 6mm emerald fire polished beads.

Step 6

Repeat Step 4 twenty times with 4mm emerald fire polished beads.

Step 7

Place one 3mm Lime crystal bicone bead onto one head pin, making one unit. Turn a simple loop at the open end of the head pin.

Step 8

Repeat Step 7 nine times, making a total of 10 units with 3mm Lime crystal bicone beads.

Step 9

Repeat Step 7 ten times with 3mm Olivine AB bicone beads.

Step 10

Open one loop on one 6mm emerald fire polished bead unit, and attach it to the loop on the filigree teardrop. Close the loop.

Step 11

Open one jump ring, and string one 3mm Olivine AB bicone unit and one 3mm Lime bicone unit onto the jump ring. Use the jump ring to attach the second loop on the unit from Step 10 to one loop on a second 6mm emerald fire polished bead unit. (The two 3mm bicone beads should hang between the two 6mm emerald fire polished bead units.) Close the jump ring.

Step 12

In the same manner as in Steps 10 – 11, continue linking four more 6mm emerald fire polished bead units with jump rings, stringing one 3mm Olivine AB bicone unit and one 3mm Lime bicone unit between the fire polish units.

Step 13

In the same manner as in Steps 10 – 11, continue linking two more 6mm emerald fire polished bead units with jump rings (omit the 3mm bicone units on the jump rings).

Step 14

In the same manner as in Step 13, continue linking 10 4mm emerald fire polished bead units with jump rings.

Step 15

Attach one jump ring to the last 4mm fire polish unit. One side of the necklace is complete.

Step 16

Repeat Steps 10 – 14, making the second side of the necklace. Reverse the sequence of the 3mm Olivine AB bicone unit and the 3mm Lime bicone unit so that the necklace is symmetrical.

Step 17

Open one jump ring, and use it to attach the loop on the lobster claw to the last 4mm fire polish unit.

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
