

Unlock My Heart by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: 2 inches

Beads and other products needed for one pair of earrings:

- 2 - 5x4mm Rose Opal Egglette Czech Pressed Glass Beads (GL8394)
- 2 - 5x3mm Oxblood Pinch Czech Pressed Glass Beads (GL1783)
- 2 - 6mm Milky Pink Heart Czech Pressed Glass Beads (GL2725)
- 2 - 6mm Fuchsia Heart Czech Pressed Glass Beads (GL2724)
- 2 - 5x4mm Pink Silk Egglette Czech Pressed Glass Beads (GL8390)
- 2 - 5x4mm Ruby Egglette Czech Pressed Glass Beads (GL8396)
- 2 - 21x12mm Vermillion Red Enamelled Heart Lock Charms by C-Koop Beads (HM4765)
- 2 - 21mm Sterling Silver Flat Textured Circle Component (SS5087)
- 1 pair - 21mm Sterling Silver French Hoops with 2mm Bead (SS2607)
- 10 - 5mm Sterling Silver 19 Gauge Open Jump Rings (SS3948)
- 12 - 22 gauge Sterling Silver 1.5 inch Head Pins (SS4698)

Tools needed to complete the earrings:

Round nose pliers
Chain nose pliers
Wire cutters

Beading Techniques needed to complete the earrings:

Opening and Closing a Jump Ring
Attaching an Ear Wire
Simple Loop

Instructions to complete “Unlock My Heart” earrings:

Step 1

Place one pink silk egglette bead onto one head pin, making one unit. Turn a simple loop (see Simple Loop Technique) at the open end of the head pin. Attach the loop just made to one round component.

Step 2

Repeat Step 1 using one oxblood pinch bead. Attach the unit to the right of the pink silk egglette unit.

Step 3

Place one milky pink heart bead onto one head pin, making one unit (narrow point toward the head). Turn a simple loop at the open end of the head pin.

Step 4

Open one jump ring (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique), and use it to attach the loop on the unit from the previous step to a second jump ring. Close the jump ring.

Step 5

Open the second jump ring from the previous step, and attach it to the component to the right of the oxblood pinch bead. Close the jump ring.

Step 6

Open one jump ring, and use it to attach one heart lock charm to the component to the right of the milky pink heart bead. Close the jump ring.

Step 7

Place one rose opal egglette bead onto one head pin, making one unit. Turn a simple loop at the open end of the head pin.

Step 8

Open one jump ring, and use it to attach the loop on the unit from the previous step to the component to the right of the charm. Close the jump ring.

Step 9

Place one fuchsia heart bead onto one head pin, making one unit (narrow point toward the head). Turn a simple loop at the open end of the head pin.

Step 10

Open one jump ring, and use it to attach the loop on the unit from the previous step to the component to the right of the rose opal egglette bead. Close the jump ring.

Step 11

Place one ruby egglette bead onto one head pin, making one unit. Turn a simple loop at the open end of the head pin. Attach the loop just made to the component to the right of the fuchsia heart bead.

Step 12

Open the loop on one ear wire (see Attaching an Ear Wire Technique), and attach it to component between the pink silk egglette bead and the ruby egglette bead. Close the loop.

Step 13

Repeat Steps 1 – 12 for the second earring, reversing the direction of the ear wire in Step 12 to make a mirrored pair.

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
