

Color Wrap by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: 8 inches

Beads and other products needed for one bracelet:

- 9 - 8x11mm White Swarovski Elements Crystal Drop Pearls (PL6514)
- 1 - 24 Gauge Round Fuchsia Artistic Wire (AW2123)
- 1 - 24 Gauge Round Christmas Green Artistic Wire (AW2121)
- 1 - 24 Gauge Round Peacock Blue Artistic Wire (AW2118)
- 1 - 24 Gauge Round Silver Blue Artistic Wire (AW2127)
- 1 - 24 Gauge Round Orchid Artistic Wire (AW2128)
- 1 - 12x7mm Silver Plated Base Metal Lobster Claw Clasp (BM3150)
- 1 - 6mm Silver-Filled 19 Gauge Closed Jump Ring (SF0214)

Tools needed to complete the bracelet:

Round nose pliers
Chain nose pliers
Wire cutters

Beading Techniques needed to complete the bracelet:

Wire Wrapping - Around a Bead

Instructions to complete “Color Wrap” bracelet:

Step 1

Using a 5-inch length of silver blue wire, make a wire wrapped link with wire wrapped around one crystal drop pearl (see Wire Wrapping - Around a Bead Technique). Connect one side of this link (the narrow end of the bead) to the loop on the lobster claw, and complete the other side of this link without connecting it to anything.

Step 2

Using a 5-inch length of fuchsia wire, make a wire wrapped link with wire wrapped around one crystal drop pearl. Connect one side of this link (the narrow end of the bead) to the unattached side of the link from Step 1, and complete the other side without connecting it to anything.

Step 3

In the same manner as in the previous steps, create and connect wire wrapped links using the indicated wire colors in the following sequence. The narrow ends of the beads should all face the same way. Each link connects to the one listed directly before and directly after it:

- 1 – peacock blue wire
- 1 – orchid wire
- 1 – Christmas green wire
- 1 – silver blue wire
- 1 – fuchsia wire
- 1 – peacock blue wire
- 1 – orchid wire
- closed jump ring
