## **Beads and other products needed for one ring:**

10 - 2x3mm Antique Gold Plated Pewter Faceted Spacers by TierraCast® (GP0186)  
1 - 9x15.5mm Antique Gold Plated Pewter Honey Bee Bead by TierraCast® (GP0170)  
1 - 21mm Brass Square Collage Ring (PE3211)  
Decorative paper

## **Tools needed to complete the ring:**

Scissors  
ICE Resin, 1 ounce Syringe Dispenser (TL2510)  
5 Piece Nylon Brush Set (CR0659)  
Sealant by Nunn Design (CR0478)  
Glue by Nunn Design (CR0479)

## **Beading Techniques needed to complete the ring:**

Using ICE Resin with Collage Pendants  
Making a Domed Surface with ICE Resin

**Instructions to complete “Baby Bee” ring:**

**Step 1**

Cut a square piece of paper to fit inside the ring finding.

**Step 2**

Using sealant and a paint brush, seal both sides of the paper, including the edges. When dry, apply a second coat. Using glue, adhere the paper to the inside of the ring finding. Allow the glue to dry.

**Tip**

*To keep the ring finding upright while the resin cures, pierce the bottom of a disposable cup and place the ring through the hole in the upside-down cup, or embed it in a soft but stable substance such as a bowl of uncooked rice or modeling clay.*

**Step 3**

Using a small dot of glue, adhere the bee bead and the spacers onto the paper in the arrangement of your choice.

**Step 4**

Mix the two parts of the ICE Resin, and fill the ring finding with resin (see Using ICE Resin with Collage Pendants Technique). Allow the resin to cure completely.

**Step 5**

Give the top of the ring a domed surface (see Making a Domed Surface with ICE Resin Technique). Allow the resin to cure completely.
