### **Beads and other products needed for one pair of earrings:**

Any one pair of beads:

- 2 - 11.5mm Enameled Delft Turquoise Small 5 Petal Flower Components by C-Koop Beads (HM2284)
- 2 - 15mm Vermillion Red Enameled Medium 5 Petal Flower Components by C-Koop Beads (HM4813)
  
- 2 - 11.5mm Calamine Blue Enameled Small 5 Petal Flower Components by C-Koop Beads (HM4804)
- 2 - 15mm Olive Enameled Medium 5 Petal Flower Components by C-Koop Beads (HM4809)
  
- 2 - 11.5mm Ultramarine Blue Enameled Small 5 Petal Flower Components by C-Koop Beads (HM4800)
- 2 - 15mm Enameled White Medium 5 Petal Flower Components by C-Koop Beads (HM2134)
  
- 2 - 11.5mm Light Mustard Enameled Small 5 Petal Flower Components by C-Koop Beads (HM4798)
- 2 - 15mm Pink Enameled Medium 5 Petal Flower Components by C-Koop Beads (HM4805)
  
- 2 - 11.5mm Orange Enameled Small 5 Petal Flower Components by C-Koop Beads (HM4797)
- 2 - 15mm Wisteria Purple Enameled Medium 5 Petal Flower Components by C-Koop Beads (HM4806)

Plus the following:

- 2 - 3mm Sterling Silver Round Beads (SS0520)
- 1 pair - 12mm Sterling Silver French Ear Wires with 2mm Ball (SS4036)
- 2 - Sterling Silver Head Pin - 22 gauge - 3 inch (SS2503)

### **Tools needed to complete the earrings:**

Round nose pliers  
Chain nose pliers  
Wire cutters

**Beading Techniques needed to complete the earrings:**

Bent Head Pin Bail

**Instructions to complete "Petal Power" earrings:**

**Tip**

*Earrings shown in the photo use the pairs of beads listed above. Mix and match beads as you please!*

**Step 1**

Place these beads onto one head pin, making one unit:

1 - silver seamless bead

1 - 11.5mm small flower component (cupped side toward the previous bead)

1 - 15mm medium flower component (cupped side toward the previous bead)

**Step 2**

Make a bent head pin wrapped loop at the end of the head pin (see Bent Head Pin Bail Technique), attaching the unit to the loop on one ear wire.

**Step 3**

Repeat Steps 1 - 2 for the second earring.
