Approximate finished length: 1.75 inches

Beads and other products needed for one pair of earrings:

- 1 - Size 11 Silver Lined Light Red Round Japanese Seed Beads (SB1790)
- 1 - Size 11 Silver Lined Dark Holiday Green Round Japanese Seed Beads (SB2130)
- 2 - 10x13.5mm Antique Silver Plated Pewter Bow Beads by TierraCast® (SP0187)
- 2 - 19x19mm Rhodium Plated Pewter Large Hammered Circle Rings (SP2269)
- 1 pair - 18mm Sterling Silver French Ear Wires with 2.5mm Bead and Coil (SS4034)
- 28 inches - 26 Gauge Green Artistic Wire (AW2153)

Tools needed to complete the earrings:

Round nose pliers
Chain nose pliers
Wire cutters

Instructions to complete "Wreath" earrings:

Step 1

Using wire cutters, cut two 14-inch lengths of wire.

Step 2

Anchor one end of one 14-inch length of wire onto one circle ring by wrapping it a few times.

Tip

In the following steps, seed beads will be strung randomly. Mix together a small amount of each of the two seed bead colors in a pile, and scoop them up with the end of the wire randomly.

Step 3

String about 1 inch of seed beads from the mix onto the wire. Pull the beads close to the component, and wrap the wire through the hole and around the component. Continue in the same manner until the entire component is covered. The last strung seed bead should reach the front of the component.

Step 4

String one bow bead and three seed beads onto the wire, and pull close to the component. The bow should be on the front of the component. Anchor the wire around the component.

Step 5

Wire wrap (see Wire Wrapping Technique) the wire to the loop on one ear wire.

Step 6

Repeat Steps 2 – 5 for the second earring.

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
