Approximate finished length: 2.5 inches

Beads and other products needed for one pair of earrings:

- 22 - 4.5mm White Potato Freshwater Pearls (PL0557)
- 2 - 38x15mm Gold-Filled Marquise Round Wire Components (GF3047)
- 1 pair - 14mm Gold-Filled Ear Wires with Coil (GF2108)
- 2 inches - 1.5mm Gold-Filled Cable Chain (CN1111)
- 4 - 4.3mm Gold-Filled 19 Gauge Jump Rings (GF2704)
- 22 - 26 gauge Gold-Filled 1.5 inch Head Pins (GF2754)

Tools needed to complete the earrings:

- Round nose pliers
- Chain nose pliers
- Wire cutters

Beading Techniques needed to complete the earrings:

- Opening and Closing a Jump Ring
- Wire Wrapping

Instructions to complete “Bride to Be” earrings:

Step 1

Using wire cutters, cut the chain into two 1-inch lengths. Set aside one length for the second earring.

Step 2

Place one pearl onto a head pin, making one unit. Wire wrap this unit (see Wire Wrapping Technique) to one end link of one length of chain.

Step 3

In the same manner as in the previous step, wire wrap two units, one pearl per unit, to the third chain link (the end link used in the previous step is the first link).

Step 4

Repeat Step 3 four times, wire wrapping two units per chain link, and skipping one chain link after each, for a total of 11 pearls attached.

Step 5

Open one jump ring (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique). Use the jump ring to attach the unattached end chain link to one marquise component. Close the jump ring.

Step 6

Open one jump ring, and use it to attach the jump ring from the previous step to the loop on one ear wire so that the cluster of pearls attached to the chain hangs down inside the component. Close the jump ring.

Step 7

Repeat Steps 2 – 6 for the second earring.
