

# Peaches and Cream by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: 18 inches

## Beads and other products needed for one necklace:

- 2 - 3mm Padparadscha Swarovski Elements Crystal Bicone Beads (03BI1106)
- 108 - 4mm Greige Swarovski Elements Bicone Beads (04BI1447)
- 108 - 4mm Padparadscha Swarovski Elements Crystal Bicone Beads (04BI1108)
- 106 - 4mm Rosaline Fire Polished Round Glass Beads (FP0241)
- 1 - 40mm Cherry Quartz Gemstone Donut (SE0998)
- 2 grams - Size 11 Salmon Satin Delica Beads - DB0825 (11DB0825)
- 1 gram - Size 11 Opaque Alabaster Mocha Delica Beads - DB1460 (11DB1460)
- 1 - 20x15.5mm Antique Silver Plated Pewter Large Tapered Toggle Clasp by TierraCast® (SP2147)
- 2 - 12.5x8.5mm Rhodium Plated Pewter Tall Radiant Bead Cones by TierraCast® (SP2398)
- 6 - 2x2mm Sterling Silver Crimp Beads (SS4047)
- 1 - Crystal Clear FireLine Braided Bead Thread .008 diameter, 6 lb/Size D (SM4429)
- 40 inches - Clear Soft Flex Beading Wire .014 diameter (SM0310)
- 6 inches - 22 Gauge Sterling Silver Half Hard Wire (SW0116)

## Tools needed to complete the necklace:

- Round nose pliers
- Chain nose pliers
- Wire cutters
- Crimping pliers (TL0500)
- Scissors
- Size 12 Pony Beading Needles (TL2382)
- Perfect End Thread Burner

## Beading Techniques needed to complete the necklace:

Crimping

Wire Wrapping

Multi-Strand Piece with Cones

Flat Peyote Stitch - Even Count

Flat Peyote Tube Bead

## Instructions to complete "Peaches and Cream" necklace:

### **Step 1**

Thread a needle with 4 feet of beading thread. String the following beads onto the thread:

1 - opaque alabaster mocha Delica bead

4 - salmon satin Delica beads

1 - opaque alabaster mocha Delica bead

### **Step 2**

Weave a flat peyote strip (see Flat Peyote Stitch - Even Count Technique) that is 70 rows long (you'll be able to count 35 beads along each long edge).

### **Step 3**

Thread the strip through the hole in the donut. Stitch the ends together, forming a bail (see Flat Peyote Tube Bead Technique). Finish the thread with the Perfect End Thread Burner.

### **Step 4**

Using wire cutters, cut two 3-inch lengths of wire. Cut three 20-inch lengths of beading wire.

### **Step 5**

Make a wire wrapped loop (see Wire Wrapping Technique) at one end of one length of wire.

### **Step 6**

Repeat Step 5 with the second length of wire.

### **Step 7**

String one crimp bead and the loop on one length of wire onto one 20-inch length of beading wire. Pass the beading wire back through the crimp bead, and crimp the crimp bead (see Crimping Technique). Trim excess wire with wire cutters.

### **Step 8**

Repeat Step 7 with each of the other two strands of beading wire.

### **Step 8**

String 108 4mm Greige crystal bicone beads onto one strand of beading wire.

### **Step 9**

Repeat Step 8 with the following beads on the specified strands of beading wire:

Strand 2: 108 4mm Padparadscha crystal bicone beads

Strand 3: 108 4mm rosaline fire polished beads

### **Step 10**

Braid the three beaded strands together loosely.

### **Step 11**

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String one crimp bead and the loop on the second length of wire onto one beading wire. Pass the beading wire back through the crimp bead, and crimp the crimp bead. Trim excess wire with wire cutters.

**Step 12**

Repeat Step 11 with each of the other two strands of beading wire.

**Step 13**

String the peyote bail to the center of the braided strands.

**Step 14**

Place one cone onto the open end of one wire, pushing the cone down so that the completed end of the wire wrap and the crimped ends of beading wires are concealed by the cone (see Multi-Strand Piece with Cones Technique). String one 3mm Padparadscha crystal bicone bead onto the wire.

**Step 15**

Wire wrap the open end of the wire onto the loop of one side of the clasp.

**Step 16**

Repeat Steps 14 - 15 on the other end of the necklace.

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
