

# Feelin' Hot by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: 16.5 inches

## **Beads and other products needed for one necklace:**

- 9 - 3mm Bronze Round Czech Pressed Glass Beads (GL2938)
- 10 - 8mm Light Green Turquoise Round Czech Pressed Glass Beads (GL8620)
- 9 - 8mm Jet Matte Fire Polished Glass Round Beads (FP2088)
- 1 - 27x17mm Antique Brass Plated Brass Lobster Claw Clasp (BM0390)
- 13.5 inches - 3.5mm Oxidized Brass Plated Brass Rollo Chain (CN5399) (B)
- 3.75 inches - 5mm Gold Plated Steel Double Link Cable Chain (CN5474) (A)
- 11.5 inches - 6mm Oxidized Brass Plated Brass Oval Cable Chain (CN5448) (E)
- 6.5 inches - 6mm Oxidized Brass Plated Brass Curb Chain (CN5434) (C)
- 8 inches - 6.5mm Gold Plated Steel Square Wire Oval Cable Chain (CN5467) (D)
- 8 - 6mm Gold Plated Base Metal 18 gauge Open Jump Rings (BM2841)
- 2 - 10mm Gold Plated Base Metal 18 gauge Open Jump Rings (BM2825)
- 10 - 22 gauge Gold Plated Brass 2 inch Eye Pins (BM2664)
- 2 - 2x2mm Gold-Filled Crimp Beads (GF2788)
- 7 inches - Clear Soft Flex Beading Wire .014 diameter (SM0310)

## **Tools needed to complete the necklace:**

- Round nose pliers
- Chain nose pliers
- Wire cutters
- Crimping pliers (TL0500)

## **Beading Techniques needed to complete the necklace:**

- Crimping
- Opening and Closing a Jump Ring
- Simple Loop

## **Instructions to complete “Feelin’ Hot” necklace:**

### **Tip**

*Note that the five chain types listed above are referenced with the letters A – E. The center section of the necklace is made of seven strands attached to two large jump rings. Five strands are chains attached with jump rings (chains A – D). One strand is made of simple loop links connected together with jump rings to form a chain. One strand is strung onto beading wire and crimped. The seven strands are arranged from top to bottom with the shortest on top and the longest on the bottom. The central section is attached to two more chains (E), one on either side, forming the sides of the necklace.*

### **Step 1**

Using wire cutters, cut the chains into the following lengths:

A: 1 – 3.75” length

B: 1 – 4.5” length; 1 – 9” length

C: 1 – 6.5” length

D: 1 – 8” length

E: 2 – 5.75” lengths

### **Step 2**

Open two 10mm jump rings (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique). Attach one to each end link of chain A. (Leave the jump rings open.)

### **Step 3**

Place one crimp bead and one of the two jump rings from Step 2 onto a 7-inch length of beading wire. Pass the wire back through the crimp bead, and crimp the crimp bead (see Crimping Technique). Trim excess wire with wire cutters.

### **Step 4**

String these beads in the following sequence onto the beading wire:

1 – 8mm light green turquoise round bead

1 – 3mm bronze round bead

Repeat the sequence 8 times, adding one 8mm green turquoise round bead to the last repeat.

### **Step 5**

String one crimp bead and the second 10mm jump ring from Step 2. Pass the wire back through the crimp bead, crimp the crimp bead, and trim excess wire with wire cutters.

### **Step 6**

Attach each end link of the 4.5-inch length of chain B to the 10mm jump rings.

### **Step 7**

Place one 8mm jet matte fire polished bead onto one eye pin, making one unit. Turn a simple loop (see Simple Loop Technique) at the open end of the eye pin.

### **Step 8**

Repeat Step 7 eight times.

### **Step 9**

Open one 6mm jump ring, and use it to attach two units made in Steps 7 – 8.

### **Step 10**

In the same manner as in Step 9, continue using 6mm jump rings to attach the remaining units together into a single continuous chain of simple loop links.

### **Step 11**

Attach each unattached end loops to the 10mm jump rings.

**Step 12**

Attach each end link of chain C to the 10mm jump rings.

**Step 13**

Attach each end link of chain D to the 10mm jump rings.

**Step 14**

Attach each end link of the 9-inch length of chain B to the 10mm jump rings.

**Step 15**

Attach one end link of one length of chain E to one 10mm jump ring. Close the jump ring.

**Step 16**

Repeat Step 15 with the second length of chain E on the other 10mm jump ring.

**Step 17**

Open the unattached end link on one length of chain E, and attach it to the loop on the lobster claw. Close the link.

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
