- 1 - 10mm Olivine Silver-Foiled Textured Round Czech Lampwork Glass Bead (CZ4979)
- 1 - 10mm Capri Blue Silver-Foiled Textured Round Czech Lampwork Glass Bead (CZ4986)
- 1 - 10mm Light Rose Silver-Foiled Textured Round Czech Lampwork Glass Bead (CZ4991)
- 1 - 22x20mm Antique Copper Plated Pewter Bird Charm by Nunn Design (BM0464)
- 1 - 25x8.5mm Antique Copper Plated Pewter Stacking Twig Connector Bar by Nunn Design (BM0448)
- 1 - 35x31.5mm Antique Copper Plated Pewter Grande Circle Collage Open Back Pendant by Nunn Design (PE9092)
- 1 - 15x9mm Antique Copper Plated Brass Lobster Claw Clasp (BM0382)
- 15.5 inches - 3mm Antique Copper Plated Base Metal Flat Oval Cable Chain (CN4121)
- 5 - 6mm Antique Copper Plated Base Metal 18 Gauge Open Jump Rings (BM0237)
- 3 - 20 gauge 2 inch Antique Copper Color Eye Pins (BM0261)

## **Tools needed to complete the necklace:**

Round nose pliers  
Chain nose pliers  
Wire cutters

## **Beading Techniques needed to complete the necklace:**

Opening and Closing a Jump Ring  
Simple Loop

## **Instructions to complete “Soaring Sparrow” necklace:**

### **Step 1**

Cut the chain into the following lengths:

1 – 2.5” length

1 – 6” length

1 – 7” length

### **Step 2**

Place one light rose textured glass bead onto one eye pin, making one unit. Turn a simple loop (see Simple Loop Technique) at the open end of the eye pin. Attach the loop just made to one end link of the 6-inch length of chain.

### **Step 3**

Open the unattached loop on the unit from the previous step, and attach it to one end link of the 2.5-inch length of chain. Close the loop.

### **Step 4**

Place one Capri blue textured glass bead onto one eye pin, making one unit. Turn a simple loop at the open end of the eye pin. Attach the loop just made to the unattached end link of the 2.5-inch length of chain.

### **Step 5**

Open the unattached loop on the unit from the previous step, and attach it to one end link of the 7-inch length of chain. Close the loop.

### **Step 6**

Measure the 2.5-inch length of chain to identify the chain link 0.75-inch from the Capri blue bead. Open one jump ring (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique), and use it to attach one loop on the stacking twig connector bar to the identified chain link. Close the loop.

### **Step 7**

Open one jump ring, and use it to attach the second loop on the twig connector bar to the loop on the open back pendant. Close the jump ring.

### **Step 8**

Place one olivine textured glass bead onto one eye pin, making one unit. Turn a simple loop at the open end of the eye pin. Attach the loop just made to the loop on the bird charm.

### **Step 9**

Open one jump ring, and use it to attach the unattached loop on the unit from the previous step to the jump ring attached in Step 7. Close the jump ring.

### **Step 10**

Open two jump rings. Use one jump ring to attach the loop on the lobster claw to one end of the necklace. Attach the other jump ring to the other end of the necklace. Close both jump rings.

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
