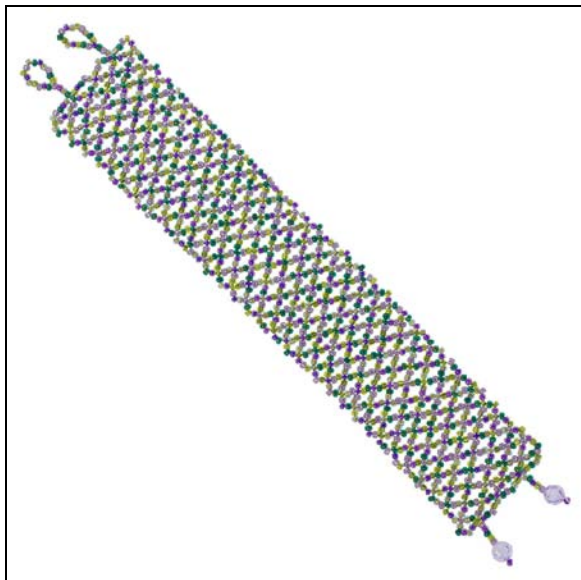


Lavender Fields by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: 7.25 inches

Beads and other products needed for one bracelet:

- 2 - 6mm Violet Swarovski Elements Crystal Round Beads (06RD0152)
- 1 - Size 11 Green Lined Rainbow Peridot Round Japanese Seed Beads by Toho - 387 (SB5810)
- 1 - Size 11 Violet Lined Transparent Purple Round Japanese Seed Beads (SB2409)
- 1 - Size 11 Silver Lined Light Olive Green Round Japanese Seed Beads (SB1587)
- 1 - Size 11 Light Copper Lined Transparent Light Aqua Blue Round Japanese Seed Beads (SB1591)
- 1 - Size 11 Silver Lined Purple Opal Round Japanese Seed Beads (SB1966)
- 1 - Crystal Clear FireLine Braided Bead Thread .008 diameter, 6 lb/Size D (SM4429)

Tools needed to complete the bracelet:

- Scissors
- Size 12 Pony Beading Needles (TL2382)
- Synthetic Beeswax (TL1026)
- Perfect End Thread Burner

Beading Techniques needed to complete the bracelet:

- Basic Netting
- Netting Clasp - Option 1

Instructions to complete “Lavender Fields” bracelet:

Step 1

Thread a needle with 5 feet of beading thread. Condition the thread with synthetic beeswax.

Step 2

Using the seed beads mixed together randomly, weave a netted bracelet 4 rows wide by 31 rows long (see Basic Netting Technique), or the desired length.

Step 3

Weave the loop side of the clasp (see Netting Clasp - Option 1 Technique) at one end of the bracelet using the seed bead mix randomly. Reinforce the loops.

Step 4

Weave the other side of the clasp at the other end of the bracelet using two 6mm Violet crystal round beads and seed beads. Reinforce the clasp.

Step 5

Reinforce the clasp and burn all thread ends with a Perfect End Thread Burner.
