

# Gunmetal Glam by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: 17 inches

## Beads and other products needed for one necklace:

- 5 grams - Size 11 Galvanized Khaki Delica Beads - DB0452 (11DB0452)
- 1 gram - Size 15 Silver Lined Opal Khaki Brown Round Japanese Seed Beads (SB3260)
- 2 - 20mm Crystal CAL Swarovski Elements Crystal Cosmic Rings (SC4316)
- 1 - 1201 27mm Crystal Swarovski Elements Crystal Round Stone (SC7142)
- 2 - 25mm Gunmetal Plated Pewter Medium Hammertone Rings by TierraCast® (MP2038)
- 22 inches - 3.6mm Gunmetal Plated Base Metal Cable Chain (CN4013)
- 1 - 26x19mm Gunmetal Plated Pewter Anna's Toggle Clasp by TierraCast® (MP2026)
- 2 - 5mm 18 gauge Gunmetal Plated Base Metal Jump Rings (BM2831)
- 1 - Smoke Gray FireLine Braided Bead Thread .008 diameter, 6 lb/Size D (SM1001)

## Tools needed to complete the necklace:

- Chain nose pliers
- Scissors
- Size 12 Pony Beading Needles (TL2382)
- Perfect End Thread Burner (TL1006)

## Beading Techniques needed to complete the necklace:

- Opening and Closing a Jump Ring
- Flat Peyote Stitch - Even Count
- Peyote Stitch Bezel
- Using a Perfect End Thread Burner

## Instructions to complete "Gunmetal Glam" necklace:

### **Step 1**

Thread a needle with approximately 6 feet of beading thread. Using size 11 Delica beads and size 15 seed beads, stitch a peyote bezel around one 27mm Crystal round stone (see Peyote Stitch Bezel Technique) using the following pattern:

Rows 1 and 2: string 72 Delica beads

Row 3: 36 Delica beads

Row 4 (back of the stone): 36 size 15 seed beads

Row 5 (back of the stone): 36 size 15 seed beads

Row 6 (front of the stone): 36 size 15 seed beads

Row 7 (front of the stone): 36 size 15 seed beads

Row 8 (front of the stone): 36 size 15 seed beads

### **Step 2**

Weave through beads to exit a Delica bead in Row 2.

### **Step 3**

String one Delica, and pass through the next Delica in the row.

### **Step 4**

Repeat Step 3 three times.

### **Step 5**

Using the beads added in Steps 3 - 4 as the first row, weave a flat band six beads wide and 24 rows long (see Flat Peyote Stitch - Even Count).

### **Step 6**

Fold the end of the peyote band around one hammertone ring toward the back (with the beveled stone facing up), and stitch the end row to the band five rows from the edge of the bezel. Weave through a few beads. Trim thread, and burn the thread end with a Perfect End thread burner (see Using a Thread Burner Technique).

### **Step 7**

Anchor a new thread in the back of the bezel. From row 2 of the bezel, exit the ninth Delica bead from the edge of the first peyote band.

### **Step 8**

Repeat Steps 3 - 7.

### **Step 9**

Thread a needle with 3 feet of thread. Leaving a 6-inch tail, use Delica beads to weave a peyote band 6 beads wide and 48 rows long.

### **Step 10**

In the same manner as in Step 6, fold and stitch one end of the band around one Cosmic ring. Weave through a few beads, trim thread, and burn the thread end.

### **Step 11**

In the same manner as in the previous step, fold and stitch the other end of the band around the hammertone ring from Step 6. Weave through a few beads, trim thread, and burn the thread end.

### **Step 12**

Repeat Steps 9 - 11 on the other side of the necklace.

### **Step 13**

Cut the chain into two 11-inch lengths.

**Step 14**

Thread one length of chain through one Cosmic ring. Open one jump ring (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique). Use the jump ring to attach both end links of the chain to the loop on one side of the clasp. Close the jump ring.

**Step 15**

Repeat Step 14 on the other side of the necklace.

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
