

Wine Barrels by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: 7.75 inches

Beads and other products needed for one bracelet:

- 14 - 4mm Fuchsia Swarovski Elements Crystal Bicone Beads (04BI1109)
- 7 - 5x7mm French Rose Copper Fire Polished Rondelle Glass Beads (FP1324)
- 3 grams - Size 11 Tan Lined Transparent Peridot Green Round Japanese Seed Beads (SB1448)
- 3 grams - Size 11 Hot Magenta Lined Transparent Dark Amethyst Round Japanese Seed Beads (SB1498)
- 3 grams - Size 11 Metallic Dark Purplish Bronze Round Japanese Seed Beads (SB1550)
- 3 grams - Size 11 Silver Lined Strawberry Opal Round Japanese Seed Beads (SB1951)
- 3 grams - Size 11 Matte Metallic Dark Sea Green Round Japanese Seed Beads (SB2504)
- 6 - 15x10mm Robles Wood Oval Beads (WD3295)
- 1 - 20x16mm Antique Copper Plated Pewter Spiral Toggle Clasp Set by TierraCast® (CP2384)
- 2 - 2x2mm Antique Copper Plated Base Metal Crimp Beads (BM0291)
- 2 - 3mm Copper Crimp Bead Covers (DA0134)
- 10 inches - Clear Soft Flex Beading Wire .014 diameter (SM0310)
- 1 - Smoke Gray FireLine Braided Bead Thread .008 diameter, 6 lb/Size D (SM1001)

Tools needed to complete the bracelet:

- Wire cutters
- Crimping pliers (TL0500)
- Size 12 English Beading Needles (TL1647)
- Mini Stainless Steel Bead Stopper (TL1685)

Beading Techniques needed to complete the bracelet:

- Crimping
- Crimp Bead Covers
- Beading Around a Bead

Instructions to complete “Wine Barrels” bracelet:

Step 1

Thread a needle with 5 feet of beading thread. Using a mix of all five seed bead colors and one wood bead, make one beaded bead (see Beading Around a Bead Technique) according to the following pattern:

Row 1: 13 seed beads

Row 2: 11 seed beads

Row 3: 9 seed beads

Repeat the sequence four times, then string one last row of 13 seed beads.

Step 2

Repeat Step 1 five times, making a total of six beaded beads.

Step 3

Place one crimp bead and the loop on one side of the toggle clasp onto a 10-inch length of beading wire. Pass the wire back through the crimp bead, and crimp the crimp bead (see Crimping Technique).

Step 4

Cover the crimp bead with a crimp cover (see Crimp Bead Covers Technique), and trim excess wire with wire cutters.

Step 5

String these beads in the following sequence onto the beading wire:

1 – 4mm Fuchsia bicone bead

1 – 5x7mm french rose copper fire polished rondelle

1 – 4mm Fuchsia bicone bead

1 – beaded bead

Repeat the sequence above five times, then string:

1 – 4mm Fuchsia bicone bead

1 – 5x7mm french rose copper fire polished rondelle

1 – 4mm Fuchsia bicone bead

1 – crimp bead

Loop on the second side of the toggle clasp

Step 6

Pass the wire back through the crimp bead, crimp the crimp bead, cover with a crimp cover, and trim excess wire with wire cutters.

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
