

You Spin Me Right Round by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: 16.5 inches

Beads and other products needed for one necklace:

- 4 grams - Size 11 Bronze Lined Crystal Clear Round Japanese Seed Beads (SB2088) (A)
- 4 grams - Size 11 Silver Lined Dark Pink Opal Round Japanese Seed Beads (SB1972) (B)
- 4 grams - Size 11 Silver Lined Matte Dirt Brown Round Japanese Seed Beads (SB1716) (C)
- 4 grams - Size 11 Silver Lined Blue Zircon Round Japanese Seed Beads (SB2150) (D)
- 4 grams - Size 11 Matte Opaque Crimson Round Japanese Seed Beads (SB1926) (E)
- 100 - 4mm Smoky Topaz Round Czech Pressed Glass Beads (GL1157)
- 11 - 4mm Teal Rondelle Czech Pressed Glass Beads (GL1993)
- 5 - 11mm Silver-Filled Round Wire Circle Components (SF0123)
- 1 - 13mm Sterling Silver Round Toggle Clasp (SS3864)
- 5 - 5mm Sterling Silver 22 Gauge Closed Jump Rings (SS3909)
- 2 - 2x2mm Silver-Filled Crimp Beads (SF0232)
- 2 - 3.5mm Sterling Silver Crimp Bead Covers (SS2103)
- 19 inches - Clear Soft Flex Beading Wire .014 diameter (SM0310)
- 1 - Smoke Gray FireLine Braided Bead Thread .008 diameter, 6 lb/Size D (SM1001)

Tools needed to complete the necklace:

- Chain nose pliers
- Wire cutters
- Crimping pliers (TL0500)
- Scissors
- Size 11 Pony 2 1/8 inch Long Beading Needles (TL2390)
- Perfect End Thread Burner

Beading Techniques needed to complete the necklace:

- Opening and Closing a Jump Ring
- Crimping
- Crimp Bead Covers
- Brick Stitch around a Component
- Using a Perfect End Thread Burner

Instructions to complete “You Spin Me Right Round” necklace:

Tip

The five seed bead colors used in this design have been labeled with the letters A – E in the materials list above. The letters will be referenced in the following steps.

Step 1

Using a 5-foot length of beading thread, stitch five rounds of brick stitch around the outside of one component (see Brick Stitch around a Component Technique) according to the following pattern, making increases as necessary. The number indicates the number of beads in the round; the letter indicates the bead color:

Component 1:

18 – A
23 – E
27 – D
31 – C
36 – B

Step 2

Exit the last bead in the last round, and string one jump ring. Pass down through the adjacent bead, and reinforce once.

Step 3

Trim excess beading thread with scissors, and burn the ends with a Perfect End Thread Burner (see Using a Perfect End Thread Burner Technique).

Step 4

Repeat Steps 1 – 3 four times, weaving four components in the following pattern:

Component 2:

18 – B
23 – C
27 – A
31 – D
36 – E

Component 3:

18 – E
23 – C
27 – D
31 – B
36 – A

Component 4:

18 – D
23 – E
27 – A
31 – B
36 – C

Component 5:

18 – C
23 – B
27 – A
31 – E
36 – D

Step 5

Place one crimp bead and one side of the toggle clasp onto a 19-inch length of beading wire. Pass the wire back through the crimp bead, and crimp the crimp bead (see Crimping Technique).

Step 6

Cover the crimp bead with a crimp bead cover (see Crimp Bead Covers Technique), and trim excess wire with wire cutters.

Step 7

String these beads in the following sequence onto the beading wire:

- 1 – 4mm teal rondelle glass bead
- 28 – 4mm smoky topaz round glass beads
- 1 – 4mm teal rondelle glass bead
- 1 – A
- 1 – 4mm teal rondelle glass bead
- 1 – A
- 1 – 4mm teal rondelle glass bead
- 1 – A
- 1 – 4mm teal rondelle glass bead
- 3 – 4mm smoky topaz round glass beads
- 1 – 4mm teal rondelle glass bead
- 1 – A
- 1 – 4mm teal rondelle glass bead
- 1 – A
- 1 – 4mm teal rondelle glass bead
- 1 – A
- 1 – 4mm teal rondelle glass bead
- 1 – A
- 1 – 4mm teal rondelle glass bead
- 3 – 4mm smoky topaz round glass beads
- the jump ring on component 1
- 6 – 4mm smoky topaz round glass beads
- the jump ring on component 2
- 6 – 4mm smoky topaz round glass beads
- the jump ring on component 3
- 6 – 4mm smoky topaz round glass beads
- the jump ring on component 4
- 6 – 4mm smoky topaz round glass beads
- the jump ring on component 5
- 42 – 4mm smoky topaz round glass beads
- 1 – 4mm teal rondelle glass bead

Step 8

String one crimp bead and the other side of the clasp onto the beading wire. Pass the wire back through the crimp bead, and crimp the crimp bead. Cover the crimp with a crimp bead cover, and trim excess wire with wire cutters.

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
