

# Globetrotting by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: 7 inches

## **Beads and other products needed for one bracelet:**

- 4 - 4mm Fern Green Swarovski Elements Crystal Round Beads (04RD0244)
- 1 - 6mm Fern Green Swarovski Elements Crystal Round Beads (06RD0301)
- 2 - 6mm Peridot Swarovski Elements Crystal Round Beads (06RD0115)
- 2 - 6mm Peridot Swarovski Elements Crystal Globe Beads (SC9154)
- 1 - 6mm Fern Green Swarovski Elements Crystal Globe Bead (SC9150)
- 2 - 8mm Peridot Swarovski Elements Crystal Globe Beads (SC9172)
- 2 - 8mm Fern Green Swarovski Elements Crystal Globe Beads (SC9168)
- 3 - 10mm Emerald Swarovski Elements Crystal Globe Beads (SC9185)
- 2 - 6mm Emerald Swarovski Elements Crystal Round Mini Beads (SC8552)
- 1 - 8mm Fern Green Swarovski Elements Crystal Round Mini Bead (SC8573)
- 1 - 8mm Emerald Swarovski Elements Crystal Round Mini Bead (SC8572)
- 1 - 16x12mm Gold Plated Pewter Toggle Clasp (GP2129)
- 7.25 inches - 3mm Gold Plated Steel Curb Chain (CN5978)
- 2 - 4mm Gold Plated Base Metal 20 Gauge Jump Rings (BM2748)
- 2 - 5mm Gold Plated Base Metal 18 Gauge Open Jump Rings (BM2833)
- 5 feet - 24 Gauge Round Gold Color Artistic Wire (AW2382)

## **Tools needed to complete the bracelet:**

Round nose pliers  
Chain nose pliers  
Wire cutters

## **Beading Techniques needed to complete the bracelet:**

Opening and Closing a Jump Ring  
Cutting Chain Efficiently  
Wire Wrapped Link

## **Instructions to complete “Globetrotting” bracelet:**

### **Step 1**

Using wire cutters, cut the chain into the following lengths (see Cutting Chain Efficiently Technique):

- 3 – 1” lengths
- 1 – 1.25” length
- 2 – 1.5” lengths

### **Tip**

*This bracelet is made of three strands. Complete each strand, then attach all three strands to the clasp with a jump ring. Note the chain lengths marked with \* for reference in later steps.*

### **Step 2**

#### Strand 1

Using a 3-inch length of wire, make a wire wrapped link (see Wire Wrapped Link Technique) with one 8mm Peridot crystal Globe bead. Connect one side of this wire wrapped link to one end link of one \*1-inch length of chain, and complete the other side of the wire wrapped link without connecting it to anything.

### **Step 3**

Using a 3-inch length of wire, make a wire wrapped link with one 8mm Fern Green crystal Globe bead. Connect one side of this wire wrapped link to the unattached loop on the link from the previous step, and complete the other side of the wire wrapped link without connecting it to anything.

### **Step 4**

In the same manner as in the previous steps, continue creating and connecting wire wrapped links using the indicated beads and chain length in the following sequence:

- 1 – 10mm Emerald Globe bead
- 1 – 4mm Fern Green round bead
- 1 – 4mm Fern Green round bead
- 1 – 6mm Peridot Globe bead
- 1 – 6mm Emerald round mini bead
- 1.5” chain length

### **Step 5**

#### Strand 2

In the same manner as in the previous steps, create and connect wire wrapped links using the indicated beads and chain lengths in the following sequence:

- \*1” chain length
- 1 – 4mm Fern Green round bead
- 1 – 4mm Fern Green round bead
- 1 – 6mm Peridot Globe bead
- 1 – 8mm Emerald round mini bead
- 1 – 8mm Fern Green Globe bead
- 1 – 10mm Emerald Globe bead
- 1 – 6mm Fern Green round bead
- 1 – 6mm Peridot round bead
- 1” chain length

### **Step 6**

#### Strand 3

- \*1.25” chain length
- 1 – 6mm Emerald round mini bead
- 1 – 8mm Peridot Globe bead
- 1 – 8mm Fern Green round mini bead
- 1 – 10mm Emerald Globe bead
- 1 – 6mm Fern Green Globe bead
- 1 – 6mm Peridot round bead
- 1.5” chain length

**Step 7**

Open one 5mm jump ring (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique). Use the jump ring to connect the unattached end link of each chain length marked with \*. Close the jump ring.

**Step 8**

Open one 4mm jump ring, and use it to attach the jump ring from the previous step to the loop on one side of the toggle clasp. Close the jump ring.

**Step 9**

Repeat Steps 7 – 8 on the opposite end of the bracelet.
