

# Hibiscus Delight by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: 20 inches

## **Beads and other products needed for one necklace:**

26 - 4mm Green Aqua Fire Polished Round Glass Beads (FP2423)  
12 - 6mm Teal Fire Polished Round Glass Beads (FP0413)  
1 - Hibiscus Glass Bead Mix by FusionBeads.com (MX1025)  
9 inches - 2.8mm Silver Plated Base Metal Curb Chain (CN3004)  
1 - 16x12mm Silver Plated Pewter Toggle Clasp by TierraCast® (SP2129)  
74 - 21 gauge Silver Plated Brass 1.5 inch Head Pins (BM2671)  
43 inches - 22 Gauge Non-Tarnish Silver Artistic Wire (AW2084)

## **Tools needed to complete the necklace:**

Round nose pliers  
Chain nose pliers  
Wire cutters

## **Beading Techniques needed to complete the necklace:**

Cutting Chain Efficiently  
Simple Loop  
Wire Wrapped Link

## **Instructions to complete “Hibiscus Delight” necklace:**

### **Step 1**

Cut the chain into 12 6-link lengths (see Cutting Chain Efficiently Technique).

### **Step 2**

Place all the flower beads from the bead mix and 24 4mm green aqua fire polished beads into a small bowl, and mix all the beads together. The beads will be used randomly in future steps.

### **Step 3**

Place any one bead from the bowl onto one head pin, making one unit. Turn a simple loop (see Simple Loop Technique) at the open end of the head pin.

### **Step 4**

Repeat Step 3 with each of the remaining beads from the bowl.

### **Step 5**

Using a 3-inch length of wire, make a wire-wrapped link (see Wire Wrapped Link Technique) with one 6mm teal fire polished bead. Attach one side of this wire wrapped link to the loop on one side of the toggle clasp. Attach the other side of the link to one end link of one length of chain.

### **Step 6**

Using a 3-inch length of wire, make a wire-wrapped link with one 6mm teal fire polished bead. Attach one side of this wire wrapped link to the second end link of the length of chain from the previous step, and attach the other side of the link to one end link of a second length of chain.

### **Step 7**

In the same manner as in the previous step, continue making wire wrapped links using one bead per link and connecting them in the sequence listed below:

- 1 – 6mm teal fire polished bead
- 1 – chain length
- 1 – 6mm teal fire polished bead
- 1 – chain length
- 1 – 6mm teal fire polished bead
- 1 – chain length
- 1 – 6mm teal fire polished bead
- 1 – chain length

### **Step 8**

Using a 7-inch length of wire, make a wire-wrapped loop on one end of the wire, attaching the loop to the second end link of the last chain length in the previous step.

### **Step 9**

String these beads and bead units in the following sequence onto the wire:

- 1 – 4mm green aqua fire polished bead
- All the bead units made in Steps 3 – 4 randomly
- 1 – 4mm green aqua fire polished bead

### **Step 10**

Make a wire wrapped loop at the end of the wire, attaching the loop to one end link of one length of chain.

**Step 11**

In the same manner as in Steps 6 – 7, continue making wire wrapped links using one bead per link and connecting them in the sequence listed below:

1 – 6mm teal fire polished bead

1 – chain length

1 – 6mm teal fire polished bead

1 – chain length

1 – 6mm teal fire polished bead

1 – chain length

1 – 6mm teal fire polished bead

1 – chain length

1 – 6mm teal fire polished bead

1 – chain length

1 – 6mm teal fire polished bead
