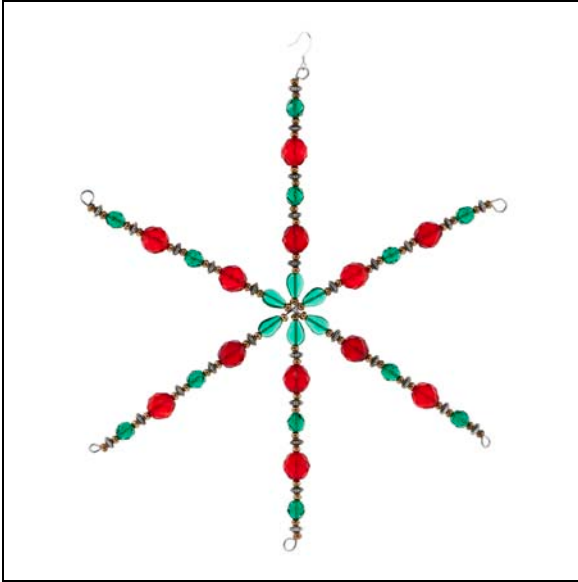


Yuletide Cheer by FusionBeads.com



Beads and other products needed for one snowflake:

- 12 beads - 8mm Emerald Fire Polished Glass Round Beads (FP2073)
- 12 beads - 12mm Siam Ruby Fire Polished Glass Round Beads (FP1722)
- 6 - 14x8mm Emerald Teardrop Czech Pressed Glass Beads (GL7828)
- 30 - 3x6mm Antique Silver Plated Pewter Crown Heishi Beads by TierraCast® (SP0315)
- 66 beads - Size 6 Gold Plated Metal Round Seed Beads (SB2981)
- 1 - 17mm Silver Plated Base Metal Ear Wire with Coil (BM3128)
- 1 - 9 inch Wire Snowflake Form (SM4203)

Tools needed to complete the snowflake:

Round nose pliers

Beading Techniques needed to complete the snowflake:

Beaded Snowflake Form

Instructions to complete “Yuletide Cheer” snowflake:

Step 1

Place these beads in the following sequence onto any one spoke of the snowflake form:

- 1 – size 6 gold plated metal seed bead
- 1 – 14x8mm emerald teardrop bead (point toward the previous bead)
- 1 – size 6 gold plated metal seed bead
- 1 – 3x6mm antique silver plated pewter crown heishi bead
- 1 – size 6 gold plated metal seed bead
- 1 – 12mm siam ruby fire polished bead
- 1 – size 6 gold plated metal seed bead
- 1 – 3x6mm antique silver plated pewter crown heishi bead
- 1 – size 6 gold plated metal seed bead
- 1 – 8mm emerald fire polished bead
- 1 – size 6 gold plated metal seed bead
- 1 – 3x6mm antique silver plated pewter crown heishi bead
- 1 – size 6 gold plated metal seed bead
- 1 – 12mm siam ruby fire polished bead
- 1 – size 6 gold plated metal seed bead
- 1 – 3x6mm antique silver plated pewter crown heishi bead
- 1 – size 6 gold plated metal seed bead
- 1 – 8mm emerald fire polished bead
- 1 – size 6 gold plated metal seed bead
- 1 – 3x6mm antique silver plated pewter crown heishi bead
- 1 – size 6 gold plated metal seed bead

Step 2

Using round nose pliers, turn a loop at the end of the snowflake spoke (see Beaded Snowflake Form Technique).

Step 3

Repeat Steps 1 – 2 with each of the remaining five spokes of the snowflake.

Step 4

Open the loop made at the end of one snowflake spoke, and attach it to the loop on one ear wire. Close the loop.
