Approximate finished length: 6.5 inches

Beads and other products needed for one bracelet:

- 12 - 6mm Bronze Preciosa Czech Crystal Round Pearl Beads (PC9052)
- 12 - 6mm Crystal Celsian Preciosa Czech Crystal Round Beads (PC0305)
- 12 - 6x4mm Crystal Honey Preciosa Czech Crystal Olive Beads (PC2502)
- 12 - 4x6mm Crystal Honey Preciosa Czech Crystal Spacer Beads (PC2019)
- 12 - 8mm Creamrose Preciosa Czech Crystal Round Pearl Beads (PC9069)
- 12 - 10mm Cream Preciosa Czech Crystal Round Pearl Beads (PC9089)
- 1 - 20.5x15.5mm Antique Silver Plated Pewter Large Tapered Toggle Clasp by TierraCast® (SP2147)
- 6 inches - 3mm Silver Plated Base Metal Flat Oval Cable Chain (CN4117)
- 2 - 5mm Silver Plated Base Metal 20 Gauge Open Jump Ring (BM2759)
- 72 - 24 gauge Silver Plated Brass 1.5 inch Head Pin (BM2687)

Tools needed to complete the bracelet:

Round nose pliers
Chain nose pliers
Wire cutters

Beading Techniques needed to complete the bracelet:

Opening and Closing a Jump Ring
Wire Wrapping

Instructions to complete “Down the Aisle” bracelet:

Tip

The beads will be used randomly in the following steps. Mix all the beads together in a small bowl to make it easier to select beads randomly.

Step 1

Place any one bead onto a head pin, making one unit. Wire wrap (see Wire Wrapping Technique) this unit to the second chain link.

Step 2

Repeat Step 1 with each of the remaining beads, wire wrapping one unit to each side of each chain link. Occasionally skip one chain link between two chain links with units attached. Leave the last chain link without a unit.

Step 3

Open two jump rings (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique). Use one jump ring to attach one side of the toggle clasp to the end chain link on one end of the bracelet and the other jump ring to attach the other side of the clasp to the end chain link on the other end of the bracelet. Close both jump rings.
