Beads and other products needed for one bracelet:

- 113 beads 4mm Olive Jade Faceted Round Gemstone Beads (SE2619)
- 102 beads 4mm Synthetic American Turquoise Faceted Round Gemstone Beads (SE2698)
- 1 15.5mm Antique Brass Plated Pewter Tree of Life Button by TierraCast (AP2143)
- 1 Smoke Gray FireLine Braided Bead Thread .008 diameter, 6 lb/Size D (SM1001)
- 6.5 feet 1mm Dark Brown Waxed Cotton Cord (SM4711)

Tools needed to complete the bracelet:

Size 10 Long Tulip Beading Needles (TL2646) Hypo Tube Cement (TL1202) Scissors Clipboard

Beading Techniques needed to complete the bracelet:

Wrapped Cord Bracelet

Instructions to complete "Tree of Life" bracelet:

Step 1

Using scissors, cut a 6.5-foot length of cord.

Step 2

String the button onto the cord to the middle of the cord. Tie an overhand knot just below the button. Clip the button to a clip board (see Wrapped Cord Bracelet Technique).

Step 3

Thread a needle with 5 feet of beading thread. Attach the thread to the cord. Wrap these beads, one bead at a time, in the following sequence into a bracelet:

- 40 4mm synthetic American turquoise beads
- 40 4mm olive jade gemstone beads
- 40 4mm synthetic American turquoise beads
- 40 4mm olive jade gemstone beads
- 20 4mm synthetic American turquoise beads
- 31 4mm olive jade gemstone beads
- 1 4mm synthetic American turquoise bead
- 1 4mm olive jade gemstone bead
- 1 4mm synthetic American turquoise bead
- 1 4mm olive jade gemstone bead

Step 4

Finish off the beading thread according to the Technique.

Step 5

Trim excess thread with scissors. Place a drop of glue on each thread knot. Allow the glue to dry.

Step 6

Tie an overhand knot after the last bead. Make one buttonhole according to the Technique. Trim excess cord.
