

# A Night's Bouquet by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: 2 inches

## **Beads and other products needed for one pair of earrings:**

- 8 - 3mm Jet Hematite 2x Swarovski Elements Crystal Bicone Beads (03BI1143)
- 8 - 3mm Crystal CAL 2x Swarovski Elements Crystal Bicone Beads (03BI1138)
- 6 - 3mm Crystal Dorado 2x Swarovski Elements Crystal Bicone Beads (03BI1150)
- 6 - 3mm Jet Nut 2x Swarovski Elements Crystal Bicone Beads (03BI1291)
- 6 - 3mm Crystal Metallic Light Gold 2X Swarovski Elements Bicone Beads (03BI1388)
- 8 - 3mm Crystal Aurum 2x Swarovski Elements Crystal Bicone Beads (03BI1399)
- 6 - 4mm Crystal Rose Gold Swarovski Elements Crystal Bicone Beads (04BI1476)
- 2 - 12mm Crystal Rose Gold Swarovski Elements Crystal Rivoli Stones (SC9076)
- 6 inches - 1.5mm Gunmetal Plated Brass Oval Cable Chain (CN5384)
- 6 - 4mm Gunmetal Plated Base Metal 21 Gauge Open Jump Rings (BM2722)
- 48 - 24 gauge Gunmetal Plated Brass 2 inch Head Pins (BM2690)
- 2 - 24x16.5mm Gunmetal Plated Pewter Twisted Round 3 to 1 Rivoli Chandelier Links by TierraCast® (MP2043)
- 1 pair - 11mm Gunmetal Plated Base Metal French Ear Wires with 1.5mm Ball (BM3091)

## **Tools needed to complete the earrings:**

- Round nose pliers
- Chain nose pliers
- Wire cutters
- 5 Minute Epoxy (TL1938)

## **Beading Techniques needed to complete the earrings:**

- Wire Wrapping
- Attaching an Ear Wire
- Opening and Closing a Jump Ring
- Cutting Chain Efficiently
- Gluing Swarovski Elements Crystal Rivoli Stones into a Rivoli Component

## **Instructions to complete “A Night’s Bouquet” earrings:**

### **Step 1**

Cut the chain into six 1-inch lengths (see Cutting Chain Efficiently Technique). Set aside three lengths for the second earring.

### **Step 2**

Mix the two parts of the 5 Minute Epoxy (see Gluing Swarovski Elements Crystal Rivoli Stones into a Rivoli Component Technique). Apply the epoxy to the center of one Rivoli chandelier link. Place one 12mm Crystal Rose Gold crystal Rivoli stone onto the epoxy, and press firmly. Allow to dry.

### **Step 3**

Open the loop on one ear wire (see Attaching an Ear Wire Technique). Attach the loop to the upper loop on the chandelier link, and close the ear wire.

### **Step 4**

Open one jump ring (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique). Use the jump ring to attach one end link of one chain length to one lower loop on the chandelier link. Close the jump ring.

### **Step 5**

Repeat Step 4 twice, attaching one chain length to each of the remaining two lower loops on the same chandelier link.

### **Step 6**

Place one 4mm Crystal Rose Gold crystal bicone bead onto a head pin, making one unit. Wire wrap (see Wire Wrapping Technique) this unit to the end link (opposite from the jump ring) of one chain length attached to the chandelier link.

### **Step 7**

Repeat Step 6 twice, once on each of the two remaining chain lengths attached to the chandelier link.

### **Step 8**

Use head pins to wire wrap any seven 3mm crystal bicone beads randomly to each of the three chain lengths, spacing them about every two to three links apart.

### **Step 9**

Repeat Steps 2 – 8 for the second earring.
