

# Crisp Days of Fall by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: 18.5 inches

## **Beads and other products needed for one necklace:**

- 1 - 6mm Smoked Topaz Swarovski Elements Crystal Bicone Bead (06BI1138)
- 1 - 11x5.5mm Dark Moss Green Swarovski Elements Crystal Pendant (SK0125)
- 1 - 16.5x9.5mm Pewter Full Pine Cone Charm by Vintaj (PW1829)
- 1 - 20mm Silver-Filled Round Wire Circle Component (SF0125)
- 1 - 12x7mm Silver Plated Base Metal Lobster Claw Clasp (BM3150)
- 18 inches - 2mm Imitation Rhodium Plated Brass Oval Cable Chain (CN5393)
- 2 - 4mm Silver Plated Base Metal 21 Gauge Open Jump Rings (BM2723)
- 2 - 5mm Silver Plated Base Metal 21 Gauge Open Jump Rings (BM2731)
- 1 - 6mm Silver Plated Base Metal 21 Gauge Open Jump Ring (BM2739)
- 1 - 24 gauge Silver Plated Brass 1.5 inch Head Pin (BM2687)

## **Tools needed to complete the necklace:**

Round nose pliers  
Chain nose pliers  
Wire cutters

## **Beading Techniques needed to complete the necklace:**

Opening and Closing a Jump Ring  
Wire Wrapping

**Instructions to complete “Crisp Days of Fall” necklace:**

**Step 1**

Open one 4mm jump ring (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique). Use the jump ring to attach the circle component to the chain. Close the jump ring.

**Step 2**

Place one 6mm Smoked Topaz bicone bead onto a head pin, making one unit. Wire wrap (see Wire Wrapping Technique) this unit to the component.

**Step 3**

Open one 5mm jump ring, and use it to attach the charm to the component. Close the jump ring.

**Step 4**

Open one 5mm jump ring, and use it to attach the pendant to the component. Close the jump ring.

**Step 5**

Use one 4mm jump ring to attach the lobster claw to one end of the chain. Attach the 6mm jump ring to the other end of the chain.
