

Teal Me Everything Bracelet by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: 7 inches

Beads and other products needed for one bracelet:

6.5 inches - 7.5mm Antique Copper Plated Steel Double Link Curb Chain (CN5994)
1 - 13.5x10mm Antique Copper Plated Pewter Anna's Toggle Clasp by TierraCast® (CP2395)
2 - 5mm Antique Copper Plated Base Metal 18 Gauge Open Jump Rings (BM0231)
1 - 5mm Turquoise Deertan Lace (SM5160)
4 inches - 24 Gauge Round Natural Artistic Wire (AW2100)

Tools needed to complete the bracelet:

Chain nose pliers
Wire Cutters
Scissors

Beading Techniques needed to complete the bracelet:

Opening and Closing a Jump Ring
Attaching a Cord End - Style 6

Instructions to complete “Teal Me Everything” bracelet:

Tip

The end of the cord is finished with a wire technique similar to the Attaching a Cord End - Style 6 Technique. Refer to the technique for general instructions.

Step 1

Using scissors, cut an 18-inch length of deertan lace.

Step 2

Fold the lace at about 6.5 inches from one end, and thread the short end through the first chain link of a 6.5-inch length of chain.

Step 3

With the short end of the lace behind the chain, thread the long end of the lace through the next chain link and wrap it around the back of the chain and short end of the lace.

Step 4

Skip one chain link. In the same manner as in the previous step, continue wrapping the long end of the lace around the chain and through every second chain link.

Step 5

When you reach the opposite end of the chain, hold the two lace ends together. Fold the ends over about a quarter inch. Using a 4-inch length of wire, wrap the wire around the lace ends, securing the ends (see Attaching a Cord End - Style 6 Technique).

Step 6

Trim the ends of the lace with scissors.

Step 7

Open two jump rings (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique). Use one jump ring to attach the loop on one side of the toggle clasp to one end link of the chain and the other jump ring to attach the loop on the second side of the clasp to the other end link of the chain. Close both jump rings.
