Tools needed to complete the bracelet:

Chain nose pliers

Beading Techniques needed to complete the bracelet:

Opening and Closing a Jump Ring

Instructions to complete “Mix it Up” bracelet:

Step 1

Open one gold jump ring (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique). Use the jump ring to attach the clam shell charm to the second chain link. Close the jump ring.

Step 2

In the same manner as in the previous step, use the specified jump rings to attach charms to the following chain links:

4th link: gold jump ring; 10x8mm crystal oval charm

6th link: copper jump ring; copper circle bird charm

8th link: silver jump ring; silver bird charm

10th link: silver jump ring; 14x10mm crystal pear charm

12th link: gold jump ring; 17x14mm antique gold plated pewter small disk charm with crystal

14th link: silver jump ring; Buddha charm

16th link: copper jump ring; feather charm

18th link: gold jump ring; mum flower charm

20th link: silver jump ring; owl charm

22nd link: silver jump ring; 14x10mm crystal pear charm

24th link: silver jump ring; horseshoe charm

26th link: copper jump ring; crown charm

28th link: silver jump ring; flower charm with crystal

30th link: gold jump ring; 10x8mm crystal oval charm

32nd link: gold jump ring; anchor charm

Step 4

Open two silver jump rings. Use one jump ring to attach the loop on one side of the toggle clasp to one end of the bracelet. Use the second jump ring to attach the loop on the second side of the toggle clasp to the other end of the bracelet. Close both jump rings.
