Approximate finished length: 3 inches

Beads and other products needed for one pair of earrings:

- 2 - 19x16.5mm Antique Copper Plated Pewter Mini Triangle Bezel Charm by Nunn Design (PE3487)
- 2 - 5.5mm Antique Copper Plated Brass 16 Gauge Open Jump Rings by Nunn Design (PE3402)
- 1 pair - 20mm Antique Copper Plated Brass Bali Style French Ear Wires (BM3371)
- 3 inches - 2mm Antique Copper Plated Brass Flat Oval Link Cable Chain (CN3203)
- 1 - 10 inch Turquoise Leather Strap by TierraCast® (CR0916)

Tools needed to complete the earrings:

- Chain nose pliers
- Scissors
- 5 Minute Epoxy (TL1938)

Beading Techniques needed to complete the earrings:

- Opening and Closing a Jump Ring
- Attaching an Ear Wire

Instructions to complete “Straight to the Point” earrings:

Step 1

Using wire cutters, cut the chain into two 1.5-inch lengths. Set aside one length for the second earring.

Step 2

Open the loop on one ear wire (see Attaching an Ear Wire Technique), and attach it to the one end link of one chain length. Close the loop.

Step 3

Using scissors, cut a triangle shape from the leather strap to fit inside one arrow bezel pendant.

Step 4

Using 5 Minute Epoxy, adhere the leather triangle piece into the pendant. Allow the epoxy to set.

Step 5

Open one jump ring (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique). Use the jump ring to attach the pendant to the last chain link. Close the jump ring.

Step 6

Repeat Steps 2 – 5 for the second earring.
