Approximate finished length: 8 inches, adjustable

Beads and other products needed for one set of bracelets:

- 3 - 10mm Silver Plated Base Metal Seamed Round Beads (BM2548)
- 20 beads - 8mm Howlite Round Beads (SE2470)
- 20 beads - 8mm Picasso Round Beads (SE2486)
- 20 beads - 8mm Black Onyx Round Beads (SE2446)
- 1 - 26x22mm Pewter Fortune Coin Charm by Vintaj (PW1814)
- 1 - 6mm Silver Plated Base Metal 18 Gauge Open Jump Ring (BM2840)
- 3 feet - Clear Stretch Magic Elastic Cord .7mm diameter (SM4433)

Tools needed to complete the bracelets:

- Chain nose pliers
- Hypo Tube Cement
- Beading Scissors 1-1/4 in. Blade (TL0302)

Beading Techniques needed to complete the bracelets:

- Opening and Closing a Jump Ring
- Knotting Stretch Magic

Instructions to complete “Rock Solid” bracelets:

Step 1

Using scissors, cut three 12-inch lengths of Stretch Magic elastic cord.

Step 2

String the following beads onto one length of elastic cord:

1 – 10mm silver bead

20 – 8mm howlite beads

Step 3

Tie a square knot in the elastic cord, and apply a dot of Hypo Tube Cement to the knot. Allow the cement to dry completely (see Knotting Stretch Magic Technique).

Step 4

String the following beads onto a second length of elastic cord:

1 – 10mm silver bead

20 – 8mm black onyx beads

Step 5

Repeat Step 3.

Step 6

Open one jump ring (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique), and attach it to the charm. Close the jump ring.

Step 7

String the following onto the third length of elastic cord:

1 – 10mm silver bead

2 – 8mm Picasso beads

The jump ring attached to the charm in the previous step

18 – 8mm Picasso beads

Step 8

Repeat Step 3.
