

Om Trio by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: 24 inches (triple-wrapped)

Beads and other products needed for one bracelet:

- 3 grams - Size 11 Light Salmon Pink Duracoat Opaque Dyed Delica Beads - DB2111 (11DB2111) (A)
- 3 grams - Size 11 Dark Salmon Pink Duracoat Opaque Dyed Delica Beads - DB2114 (11DB2114) (B)
- 3 grams - Size 11 Light Maroon Duracoat Opaque Dyed Delica Beads - DB2119 (11DB2119) (C)
- 1 gram - Size 11 Sienna Duracoat Opaque Dyed Delica Beads - DB2142 (11DB2142) (D)
- 3 grams - Size 11 Dark Imperial Blue Duracoat Opaque Dyed Delica Beads - DB2135 (11DB2135) (E)
- 3 grams - Size 11 Tiffany Blue Duracoat Opaque Dyed Delica Beads - DB2133 (11DB2133) (F)
- 1 - 17mm Antique Copper Plated Pewter Om Button by TierraCast® (CP2501)
- 5 feet - 1mm Natural Antique Round Leather Cord (SM6149)
- 1 - Superlon Beading Thread Size AA – Brown (SM4339)

Tools needed to complete the bracelet:

- Size 12 English Beading Needles (TL1647)
- 4.5 inch Scissors (TL2502)
- Hypo Tube Cement (TL1202)
- Clipboard

Beading Techniques needed to complete the bracelet:

Wrapped Cord Bracelet

Instructions to complete “Om Trio” bracelet:

Tip

The letters A – F designate the beads used in the pattern. Please refer to the materials list above for the key.

Step 1

Using scissors, cut a 5-foot length of cord.

Step 2

String the button onto the cord to the middle of the cord. Tie an overhand knot just below the button. Clip the button to a clip board (see Wrapped Cord Bracelet Technique).

Step 3

Thread a needle with 5 feet of beading thread. Attach the thread to the cord.

Step 4

The bracelet is made of three patterns (1, 2, 3), each about 7 inches long. Wrap these beads in the following sequence into a bracelet:

Repeat pattern 2 six times, then:

Repeat pattern 3 four times, then:

3 – E

Step 5

Finish off the beading thread according to the Technique.

Step 6

Trim excess thread with scissors. Place a drop of glue on each thread knot. Allow the glue to dry.

Step 7

Tie an overhand knot after the last bead. Make one buttonhole according to the Technique. Trim excess cord.
