Approximate finished length: 8.5 inches

Beads and other products needed for one bracelet:

- 9 - SS34 Crystal Iridescent Green Swarovski Crystal Xirius Flat Back Rhinestones (FT2688)
- 9 - 10.5mm Gold Plated Pewter SS34 Glue in Washers by TierraCast® (GP2491)
- 1 - 20mm Gold Plated Pewter Celtic Slide Link by TierraCast® (GP2542)
- 2 - 14.25x19mm Gold Plated Pewter Celtic End Bars by TierraCast® (GP2547)
- 1 - 16x12mm Antique Gold Plated Pewter Toggle Clasp by TierraCast® (GP2128)
- 1 - 10 inch Antiqued Copper Leather Strap by TierraCast® (CR0925)
- 2 - 5mm Gold Plated Base Metal 20 Gauge Open Jump Rings (BM2760)
- 9 - 4mm Gold Plated Pewter Compression Rivets by TierraCast® (GP2455)

Tools needed to complete the bracelet:

- Super New Glue (TL2933)
- 1 lb Heavy Brass Hammer (TL2408)
- Poly Cutting Board (TL2890)
- Craftool Dot/Rivet Anvil (TL2888)
- 4mm Rivet Setter by TierraCast® (TL2940)
- Mini Leather Punch Set (TL2889)
- Chain nose pliers
- Beading Scissors 1-1/4 in. Blade (TL0302)
- Ruler
- Pencil or pen

Beading Techniques needed to complete the bracelet:

- Riveting Using Compression Rivets
- Opening and Closing a Jump Ring

Instructions to complete “Dublin” bracelet:

Step 1

Using scissors, cut an 8 3/8-inch length of leather strap.

Step 2

Allowing 3/4 inch on each end of the strap to fold under, make nine marks on the rest of the strap 3/4 inch apart. Punch holes at the marks (see Riveting Using Compression Rivets Technique).

Step 3

Place one washer over the center hole, and rivet it onto the strap.

Step 4

Slide the slide link onto the strap and over the washer riveted in the previous step.

Step 5

Rivet a washer onto each of three holes on either side of the center washer.

Step 6

Slide one end bar onto one end of the strap, and fold 3/4 inch of the strap under. Rivet a washer through both layers of the strap, securing the end bar.

Step 7

Repeat Step 6 on the other end of the strap.

Step 8

Open one jump ring (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique). Use the jump ring to attach one side of the toggle clasp to one end bar. Close the jump ring.

Step 9

Repeat Step 8 with the second end bar.
