

Slender Segments Wrap by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: 24 inches (triple-wrapped)

Beads and other products needed for one bracelet:

30 - 2mm Brass Tiny Square Spacer Beads (HH0100)

24 inches - #18 Aqua Superlon Bead Cord (SM5370)

24 inches - 5mm Chocolate Brown Regaliz® Flat Leather Cord (SM6050)

1 - 16.5x7.5mm Antique Brass Plated Regaliz® Small Dot Magnetic Clasp (BM3732)

Tools needed to complete the bracelet:

Medium Griffin Soft Wire Twisted Needles (TL1017)

Plastic Straight Cord Cutter (TL2936)

Super New Glue (TL2933)

Beading Techniques needed to complete the bracelet:

Attaching Components to Regaliz Leather

Instructions to complete “Slender Segments Wrap” bracelet:

Step 1

Using the plastic straight cord cutter, cut a 24-inch length of flat leather cord (see Attaching Components to Regaliz Leather Technique). Wrap a 2-inch length of beading cord tightly around the center of the leather cord. Use a dab of adhesive on the back side of the leather to secure the ends of the cord. Repeat this step about 3.5 to 4 inches to the left of the center wrap and again to the right of the center wrap.

Step 2

String the twisted needle onto the beading cord, then string one 2mm square spacer bead to the center of one 3-inch length of beading cord. Place the cord on top of the leather, midway between the center wrap and the wrap to the left of center formed in Step 1. *Wrap one end of the cord around the leather once, then string one 2mm square spacer bead. Repeat. Wrap this remaining tail around the leather, remove the needle, and secure with adhesive as before. Repeat from * using the other end of the same cord.

Step 3

Repeat Step 2 twice, placing the two bead-cord wraps so that they are evenly spaced between the second wrap formed in Step 1 and the end of the leather.

Step 4

Repeat Steps 2 – 3 on the right side of the bracelet.

Step 5

Using Super New Glue, adhere one side of the magnetic clasp to one end of the cord. When attaching the clasp, make sure the top is facing the same direction as the spacer beads.

Step 6

Repeat Step 5 with the other side of the clasp on the other end of the cord.
