

Lucky Clover by FusionBeads.com



Approximate finished length: 8 inches (circumference of 1 loop), 2.5-inch diameter

Beads and other products needed for one bracelet:

- 5 grams - Size 11 Matte Metallic Dark Olive Green Round Japanese Seed Beads (SB1649)
- 10 grams - Size 6 Envy Round Japanese Seed Bead Mix by FusionBeads.com® (SB6716)
- 50 - 4mm Matte Metallic Antique Gold Fire Polished Round Glass Beads (FP3653)
- 1 - 13x8.5mm Antique Gold Plated Pewter Clover Leaf Charm by TierraCast® (GP6225)
- 1 - 5mm Gold Plated Base Metal 20 Gauge Open Jump Ring (BM2760)
- 2 - 3mm Gold Plated Memory Wire End Caps (BM3570)
- 1 - Gold Plated Memory Wire 2.5 in. diameter Bracelet (SM5335)

Tools needed to complete the bracelet:

- Chain nose pliers
- Memory Wire cutters (TL0303)
- 5 Minute Epoxy (TL1938)

Beading Techniques needed to complete the bracelet:

Opening and Closing a Jump Ring

Instructions to complete “Lucky Clover” bracelet:

Step 1

Using Memory Wire cutters, cut a 6-turn length of Memory Wire.

Step 2

Use a toothpick or short length of scrap wire to apply a small drop of 5 Minute Epoxy to the inside of one end cap. Insert the end of the Memory Wire into the end cap. Allow the epoxy to dry completely.

Step 3

String these beads in the following sequence onto the Memory Wire:

1.75” – size 11 seed beads
22 – 4mm matte metallic antique gold fire polished beads
3” – size 11 seed beads
3” – size 6 seed beads
2.25” – size 11 seed beads
2.5” – size 6 seed beads
3.75” – size 11 seed beads
5” – size 6 seed beads
2” – size 11 seed beads
28 – 4mm matte metallic antique gold fire polished beads
3” – size 11 seed beads
3” – size 6 seed beads
4” – size 11 seed beads
3.5” – size 6 seed beads

Step 4

Trim the wire if needed. Repeat Step 2 on the end of the wire.

Step 5

Open the jump ring (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique). Use the jump ring to attach the charm near the end of the wire between two size 6 beads. Close the jump ring.
