Beads and other products needed for one bracelet:

- 27 beads - 4mm Shiny Baltic Blue Czech Glass Pearl Beads (GL4542)
- 18 beads - 4mm Shiny Grey Mist Czech Glass Pearl Beads (GL4543)
- 18 beads - 4mm Shiny Pea Green Czech Glass Pearl Beads (GL4545)
- 27 beads - 4mm Shiny Hollyhock Purple Czech Glass Pearl Beads (GL4537)
- 9 - 4x15mm Antique Silver Plated Pewter 3 Hole Braided Spacer Bars by TierraCast® (SP2201)
- 2 - 10x15mm Antique Silver Plated Pewter 3 to 1 Braided Links by TierraCast® (SP2171)
- 1 - 16x12mm Antique Silver Plated Pewter Toggle Clasp by TierraCast® (SP2128)
- 4 - 4mm Silver Plated Base Metal 20 Gauge Open Jump Rings (BM2747)
- 6 - 2x2mm Sterling Silver Twisted Crimp Beads (SS4050)
- 6 - 3.5mm Sterling Silver Crimp Bead Covers (SS2103)
- 27 inches - Clear Soft Flex Wire .014" Diameter (SM0310)

Tools needed to complete the bracelet:

- Wire cutters
- Chain nose pliers
- Crimping pliers (TL0500)

Beading Techniques needed to complete the bracelet:

- Crimping
- Crimp Bead Covers
- Opening and Closing a Jump Ring

Instructions to complete “Divided” bracelet:

Step 1

Using wire cutters, cut three 9-inch lengths of beading wire.

Tip

Imagine that the three holes in the spacer bars and the loops in the 3-hole end bar links are numbered from 1 – 3. Imagine also that the three strands of beading wire are numbered from 1 – 3. Always string beading wire 1 through hole 1 in each of the spacer bars and loop 1 of the end bar links, beading wire 2 through loop 2, etc.

Step 2

Place one crimp bead and loop 1 of the first end bar link onto beading wire 1. Pass the wire back through the crimp bead, and crimp the crimp bead (see Crimping Technique).

Step 3

Cover the crimp bead with a crimp bead cover (see Crimp Bead Covers Technique), and trim excess wire with wire cutters.

Step 4

Repeat Steps 2 – 3 with beading wires 2 – 3.

Step 5

Onto beading wire 1, string these items in the following sequence:

2 – 4mm Shiny Hollyhock Purple pearl beads

Hole 1 of spacer bar 1

4 – 4mm Shiny Baltic Blue pearl beads

Hole 1 of spacer bar 2

2 – 4mm Shiny Pea Green pearl beads

Hole 1 of spacer bar 3

4 – 4mm Shiny Grey Mist pearl beads

Hole 1 of spacer bar 4

2 – 4mm Shiny Hollyhock Purple pearl beads

Hole 1 of spacer bar 5

4 – 4mm Shiny Baltic Blue pearl beads

Hole 1 of spacer bar 6

2 – 4mm Shiny Pea Green pearl beads

Hole 1 of spacer bar 7

4 – 4mm Shiny Grey Mist pearl beads

Hole 1 of spacer bar 8

2 – 4mm Shiny Hollyhock Purple pearl beads

Hole 1 of spacer bar 9

4 – 4mm Shiny Baltic Blue pearl beads

1 – crimp bead

Loop 1 of the second end bar link

Step 6

Pass the wire back through the crimp bead, and crimp the crimp bead. Cover the crimp with a crimp bead cover, and trim excess wire.

Step 7

Onto beading wire 2, string these items in the following sequence:

3 – 4mm Shiny Hollyhock Purple pearl beads

Hole 2 of spacer bar 1

3 – 4mm Shiny Baltic Blue pearl beads

Hole 2 of spacer bar 2

3 – 4mm Shiny Pea Green pearl beads

Hole 2 of spacer bar 3

3 – 4mm Shiny Grey Mist pearl beads

Hole 2 of spacer bar 4

3 – 4mm Shiny Hollyhock Purple pearl beads

Hole 2 of spacer bar 5

3 – 4mm Shiny Baltic Blue pearl beads
Hole 1 of spacer bar 6
3 – 4mm Shiny Pea Green pearl beads
Hole 2 of spacer bar 7
3 – 4mm Shiny Grey Mist pearl beads
Hole 2 of spacer bar 8
3 – 4mm Shiny Hollyhock Purple pearl beads
Hole 2 of spacer bar 9
3 – 4mm Shiny Baltic Blue pearl beads
1 – crimp bead
Loop 2 of the second end bar link

Step 8

Repeat Step 6.

Step 9

Onto beading wire 3, string these items in the following sequence:

4 – 4mm Shiny Hollyhock Purple pearl beads
Hole 3 of spacer bar 1
2 – 4mm Shiny Baltic Blue pearl beads
Hole 3 of spacer bar 2
4 – 4mm Shiny Pea Green pearl beads
Hole 3 of spacer bar 3
2 – 4mm Shiny Grey Mist pearl beads
Hole 3 of spacer bar 4
4 – 4mm Shiny Hollyhock Purple pearl beads
Hole 3 of spacer bar 5
2 – 4mm Shiny Baltic Blue pearl beads
Hole 3 of spacer bar 6
4 – 4mm Shiny Pea Green pearl beads
Hole 3 of spacer bar 7
2 – 4mm Shiny Grey Mist pearl beads
Hole 3 of spacer bar 8
4 – 4mm Shiny Hollyhock Purple pearl beads
Hole 3 of spacer bar 9
2 – 4mm Shiny Baltic Blue pearl beads
1 – crimp bead
Loop 3 of the second end bar link

Step 10

Repeat Step 6.

Step 11

Open three jump rings (see Opening and Closing a Jump Ring Technique). Attach one jump ring to one end bar link, and close the jump ring. Attach the second jump ring to the bar side of the toggle clasp. Use the third jump ring to connect the two jump rings attached in this step.

Step 12

Use one jump ring to attach the second end bar link to the second side of the clasp.
